

## PRAYERS FOR PEACE ALLIANCE

## Philadelphia Area Christians, Muslims, and Jews

We, the undersigned Philadelphia-area Christian, Muslim, and Jewish clergy and faith leaders, urge our elected representatives, including President Biden and the Pennsylvania congressional delegation, to seek an immediate and lasting ceasefire in Gaza, and pursue through diplomatic means the release of hostages and a future based upon peace, justice, and equal rights for all people in the Holy Land.

The logic of militarism – occupation, siege, and bombardment – has led us to this point. 26,000 Palestinians and 1,400 Israelis have been killed. Gaza's people have had their lives torn apart, with dangerously little access to food, water, medicine, and electricity, and the majority of homes destroyed. Palestinians on the other side of the fence are facing an unprecedented level of repression, whether by Israeli police or settlers. This war is not freeing Israeli hostages still held in Gaza. The trauma of the war will stay with both Palestinian and Israeli society for generations.

The United States government is fueling this violence by continuing to provide the Israeli military with weapons, while refusing to take measures to end the destruction in Gaza and the West Bank. This stands in contrast to the International Court of Justice, which has ruled that Israel must take action to prevent acts of genocide. It is past time for our elected officials to heed the moral call of this moment, and to recognize that continued war-making will lead only to further despair and violence.

We speak as leaders in nonviolent faith traditions, all with our own connections to the land we call Israel and Palestine. We speak also as people of varying ethnic backgrounds, in a country that has its own history of segregation and ethnic discrimination. We understand that the security and self-determination of one people cannot be achieved at the expense of the safety and rights of another people.

An immediate and lasting ceasefire is the only way to prevent more death and destruction. We call on the United States to work towards a diplomatic resolution to this war, prioritizing the immediate release of all hostages and political prisoners. Our elected representatives must live up to their stated values, and pursue a foreign policy rooted in the principles of equality, justice, and peace.
