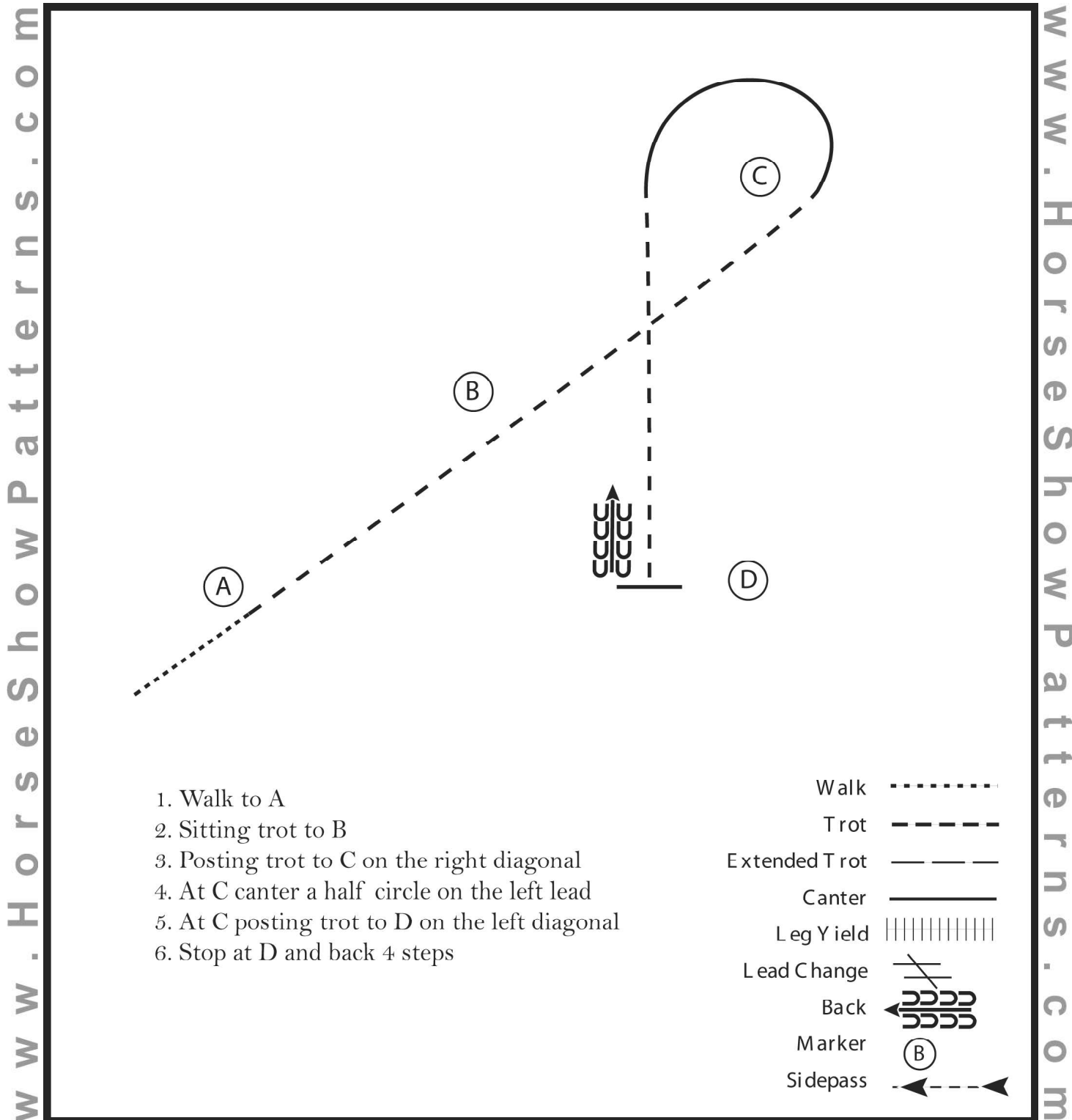

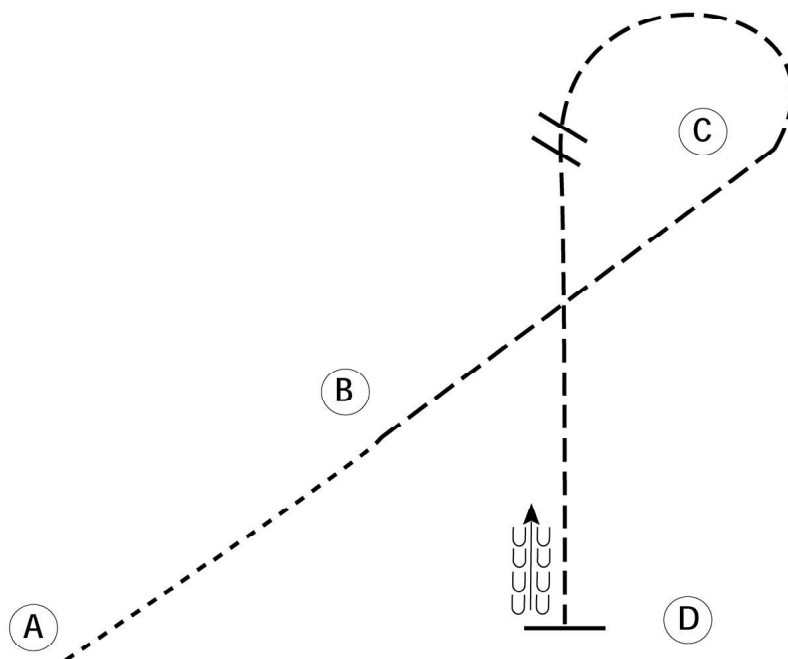

Be ready at A.

1. Walk from A to B.
2. Sitting trot from B to C.
3. At C, posting trot on the right diagonal.
4. At C, change diagonals.
5. Posting trot on the left diagonal to D.
6. Stop at D. Back approximately one horse length.
7. Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

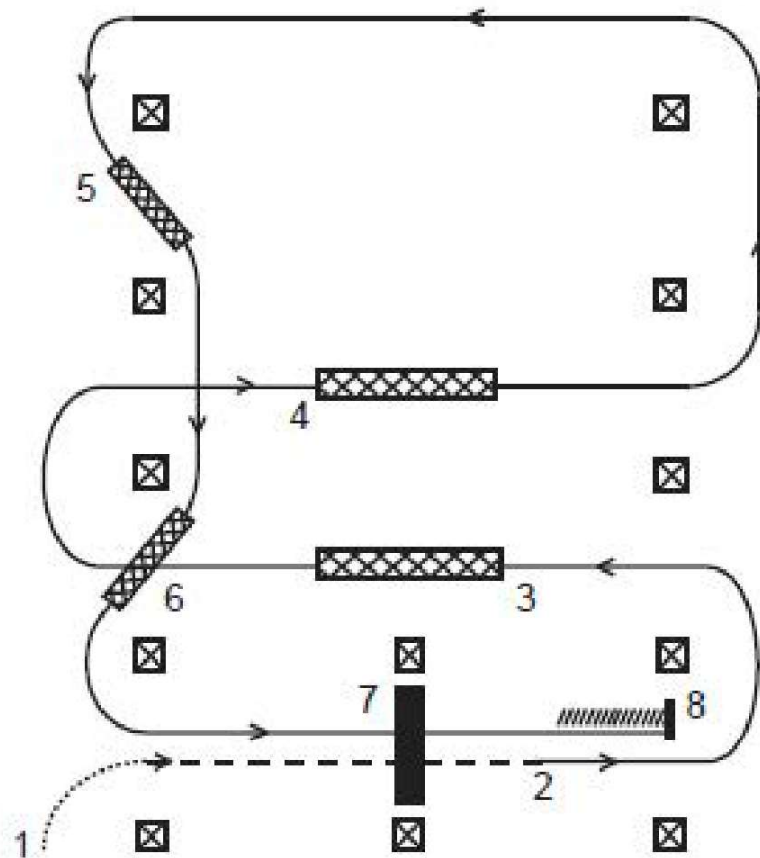


1. Walk
2. Trot serpentine
3. Lope left lead around the end of the arena and then diagonally across the arena
4. Change leads (simple or flying) and
5. Lope on the right lead around end of the arena
6. Extend lope on the straight away and around corner to the center of the arena
7. Extend trot around corner of the arena
8. Collect to a trot
9. Trot over logs
10. Stop, do 360 degree turn each direction (either direction first) (L-R or R-L)
11. Walk, stop and back



1. Walk to the left and around the corner.
2. Trot
3. Extend the trot
4. Break to a walk before the logs and walk over the logs.
5. Trot
6. Stop
7. Back one horse length.

126. Pattern B – Level I Western Riding (8-13; 14-18; 19 and Over)



Walk: Lope: _____
 Back: //////////////// Jog: - - - - -
 Lead Changing Area: XXXXXXXXX

Lead Changes may be simple or flying.

1. Walk, transition to jog, jog over log.
2. Transition to lope.
3. First crossing change.
4. Second crossing change.
5. First line change.
6. Second line change.
7. Lope over log.
8. Stop and back.

This pattern could be used for level 1 when choosing Western Riding Pattern Number 2.
