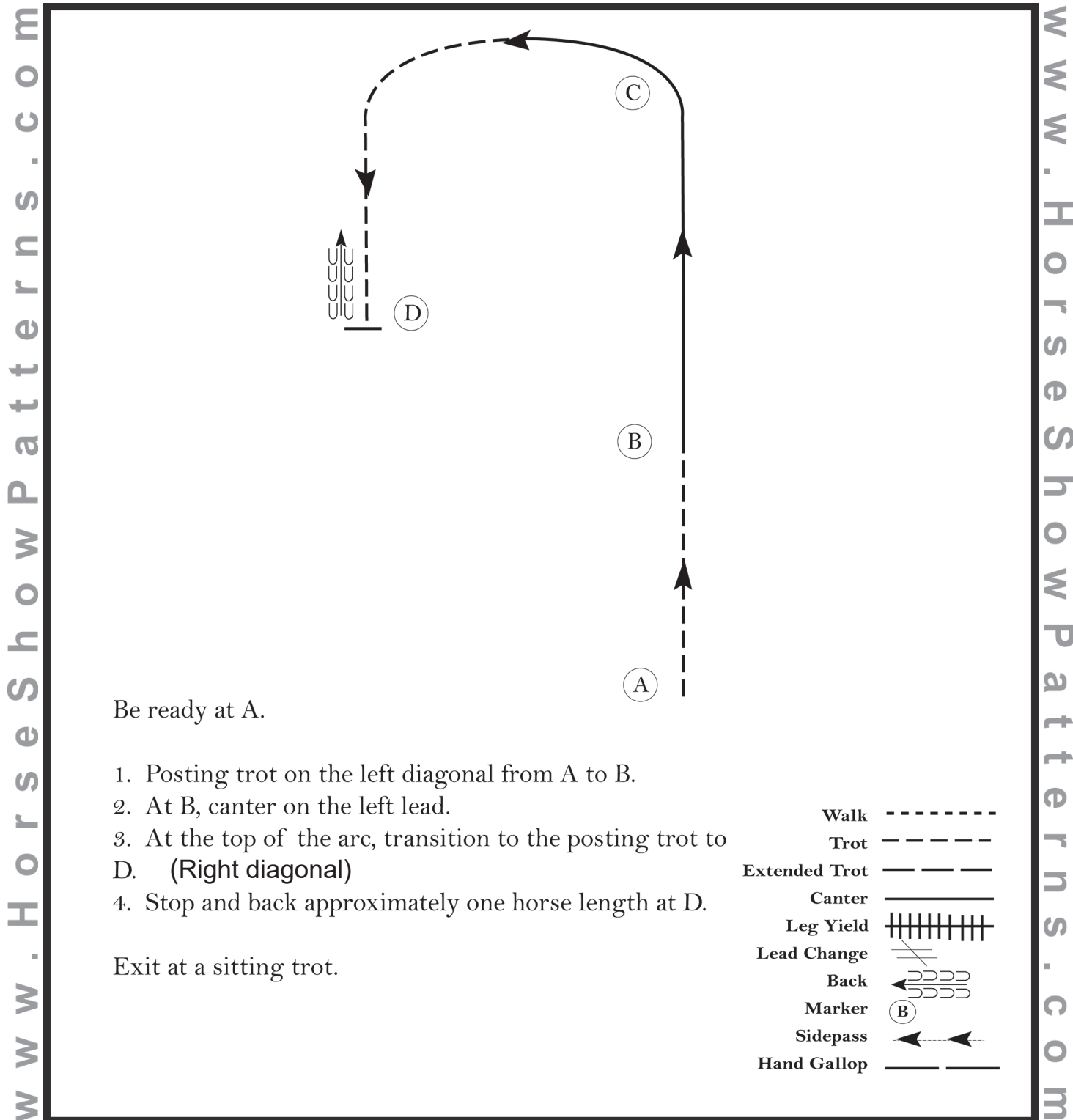

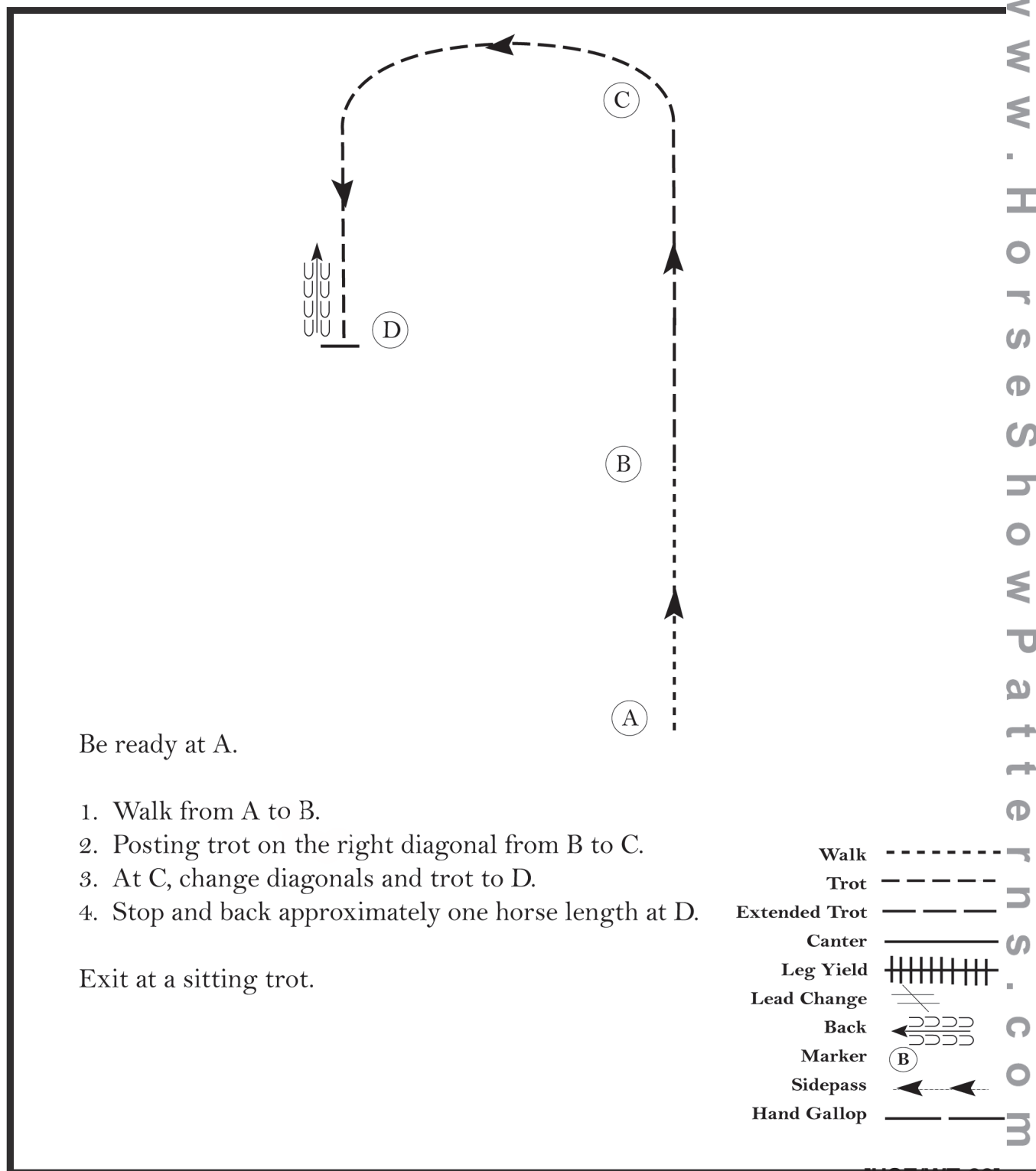

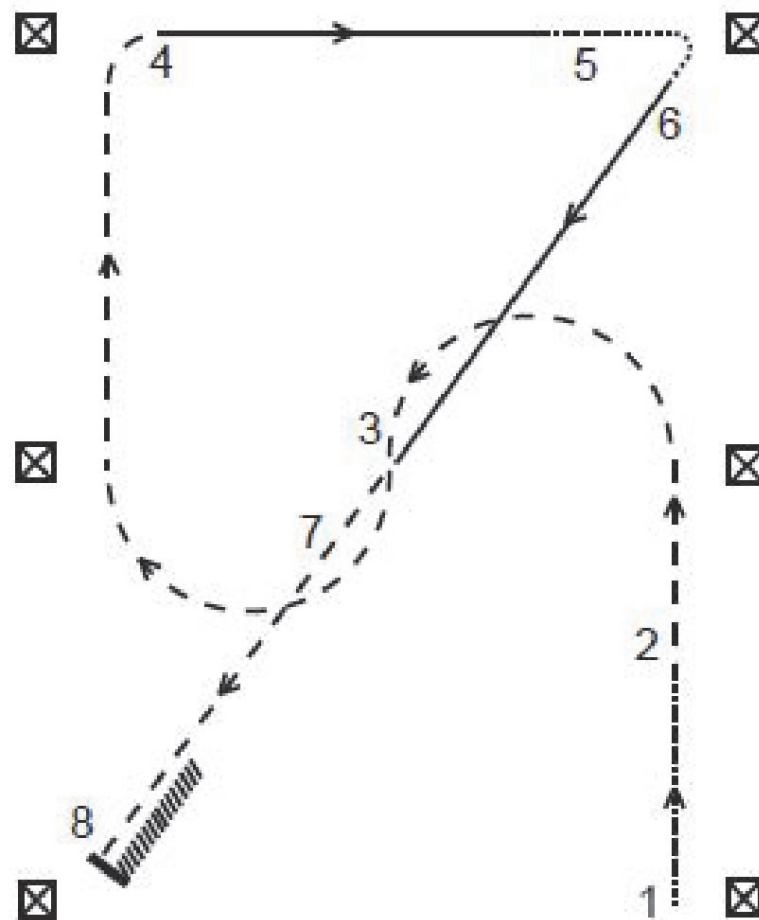
English Equitation DC 4-H Walk Trot 8-18

Walk: Canter: _____
 Back: /////////////// Trot: _ _ _ _ _

1. Normal walk.
2. Rising trot halfway between cones.
3. Serpentine showing change of diagonal.
4. Canter right lead $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way across.
5. Before corner, walk.
6. Canter left lead to the center.
7. Sitting trot.
8. Halt, back.

Leave arena on a loose rein at the free walk.

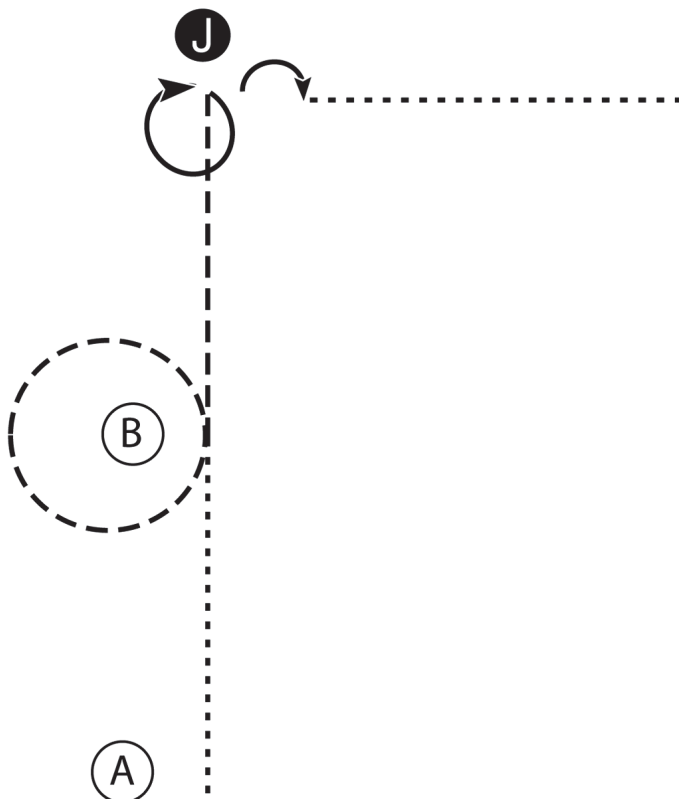

Showmanship (Western or English) (8-13)(14-18)(19 & Over)

Show Date: 02-21-2026

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1. Walk from A to B.
2. At B trot. Trot a circle around B and continue to the Judge.
3. Stop and perform a 360 degree turn. Set up for inspection.
4. When dismissed perform a 90 degree turn.
5. Walk straight away from the Judge.

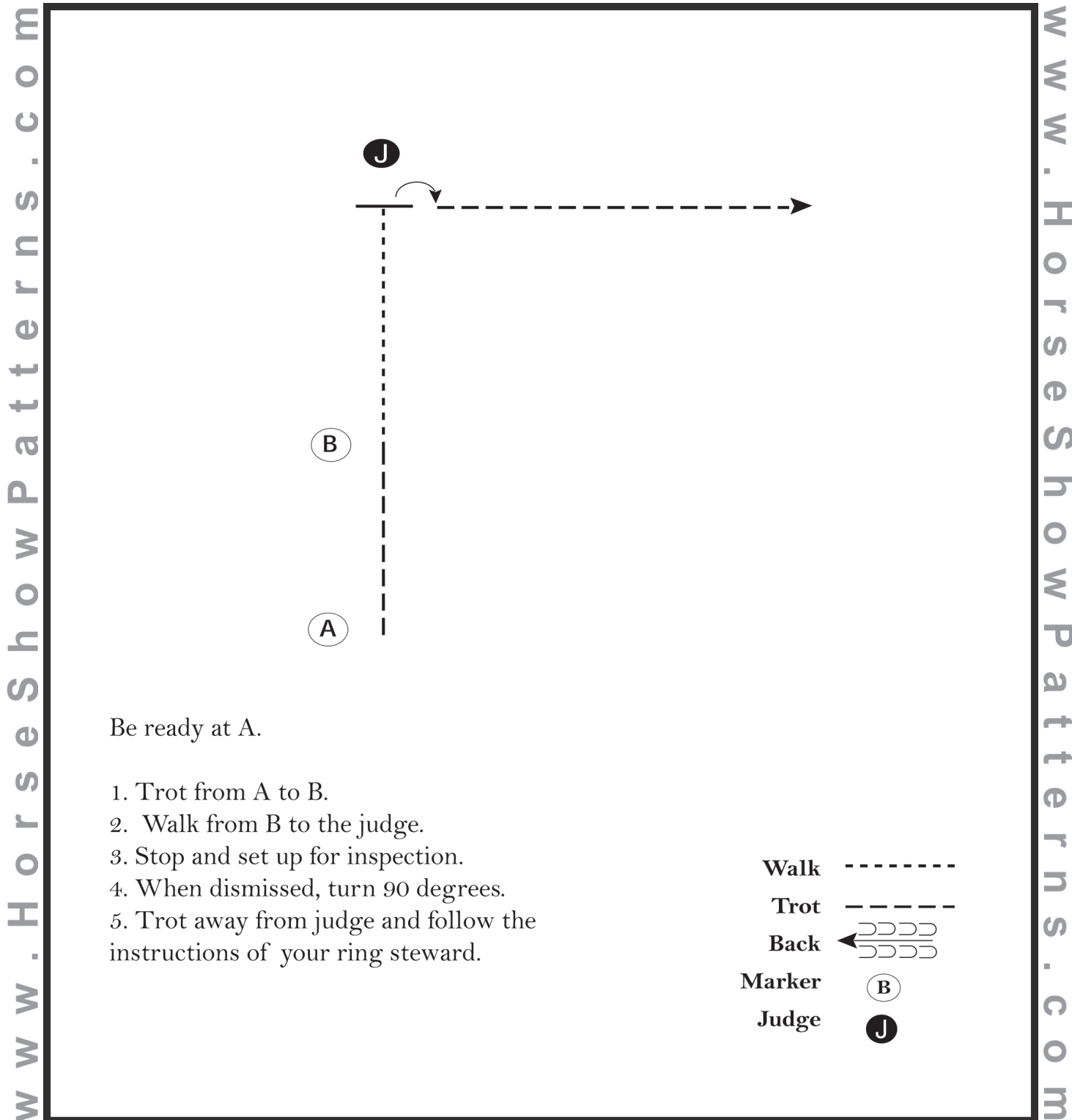

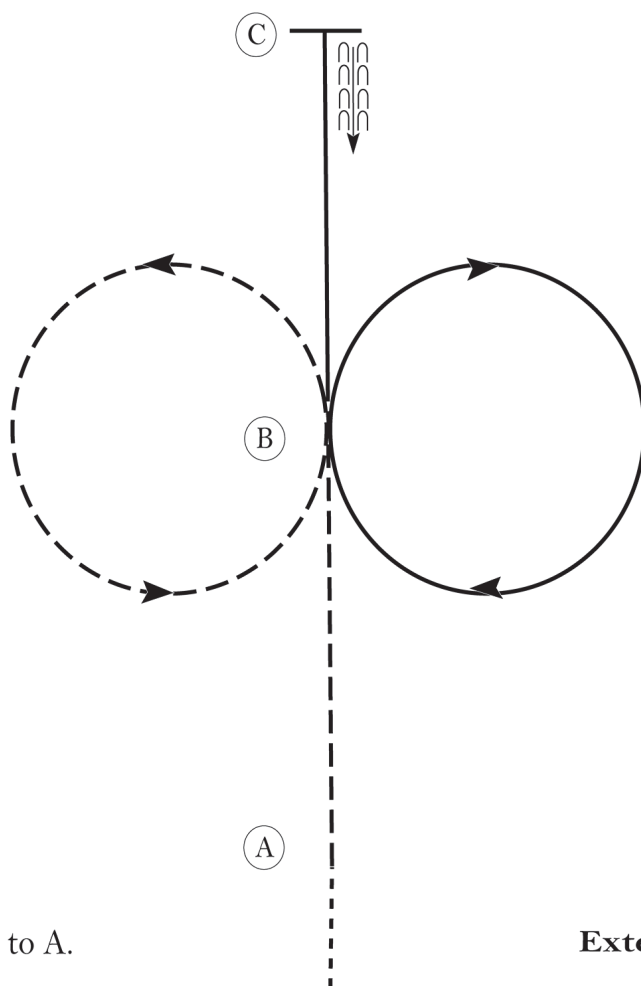

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Be ready prior to A.

1. Walk to A.
2. Jog A to B.
3. At B jog a circle to the left.
4. At B lope a circle to the right on the right lead.
5. Continue the lope to C.
6. Stop at C and back approximately one horse length.

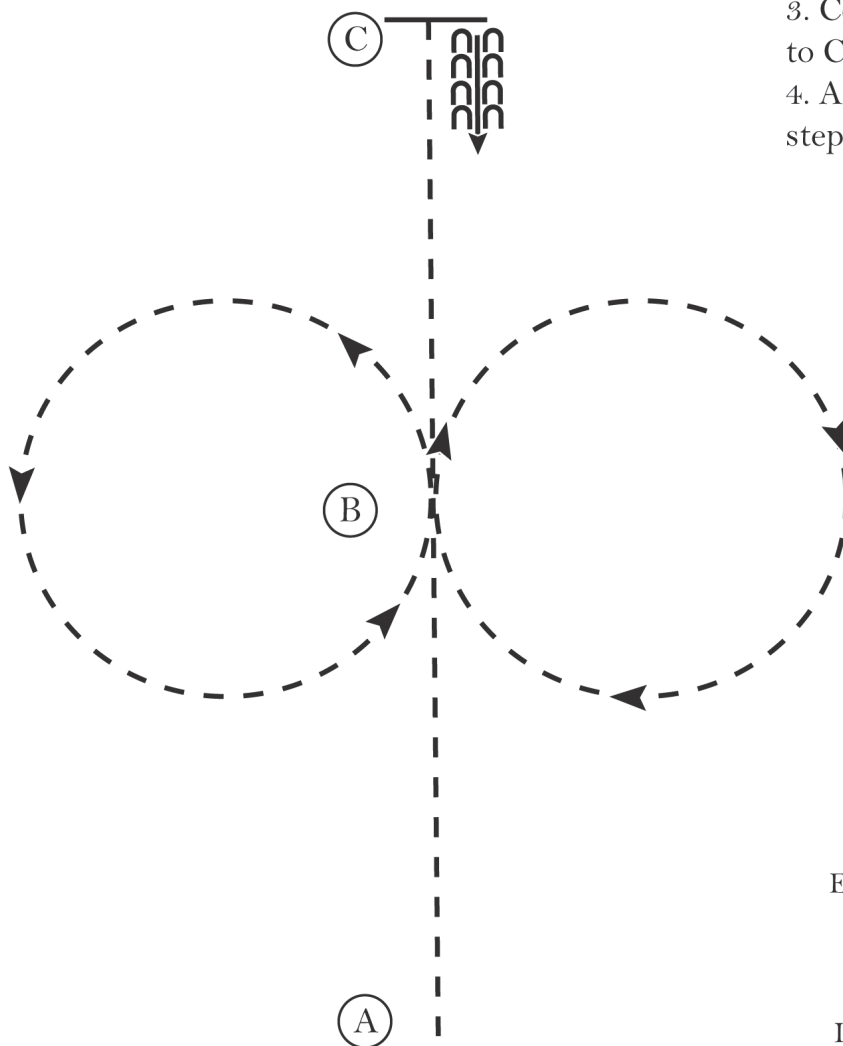
Western Horsemanship DC 4-H Walk Trot 8-18

3. Continue the jog from B to C
4. At C stop and back 4 steps

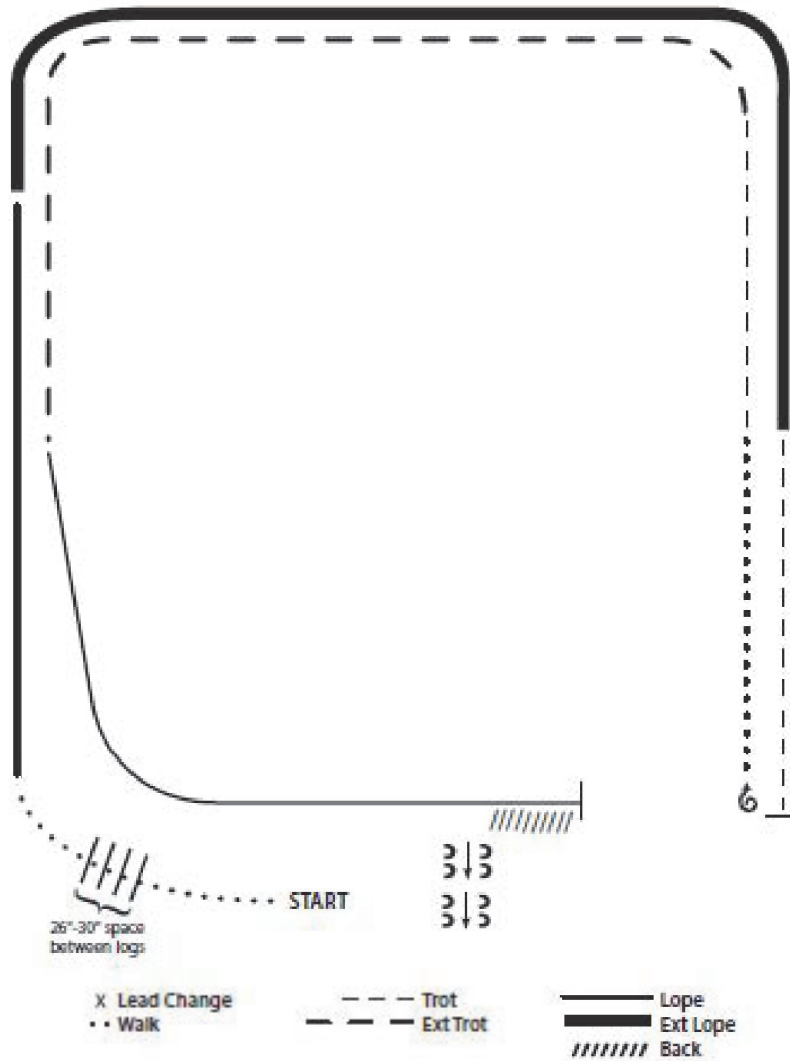

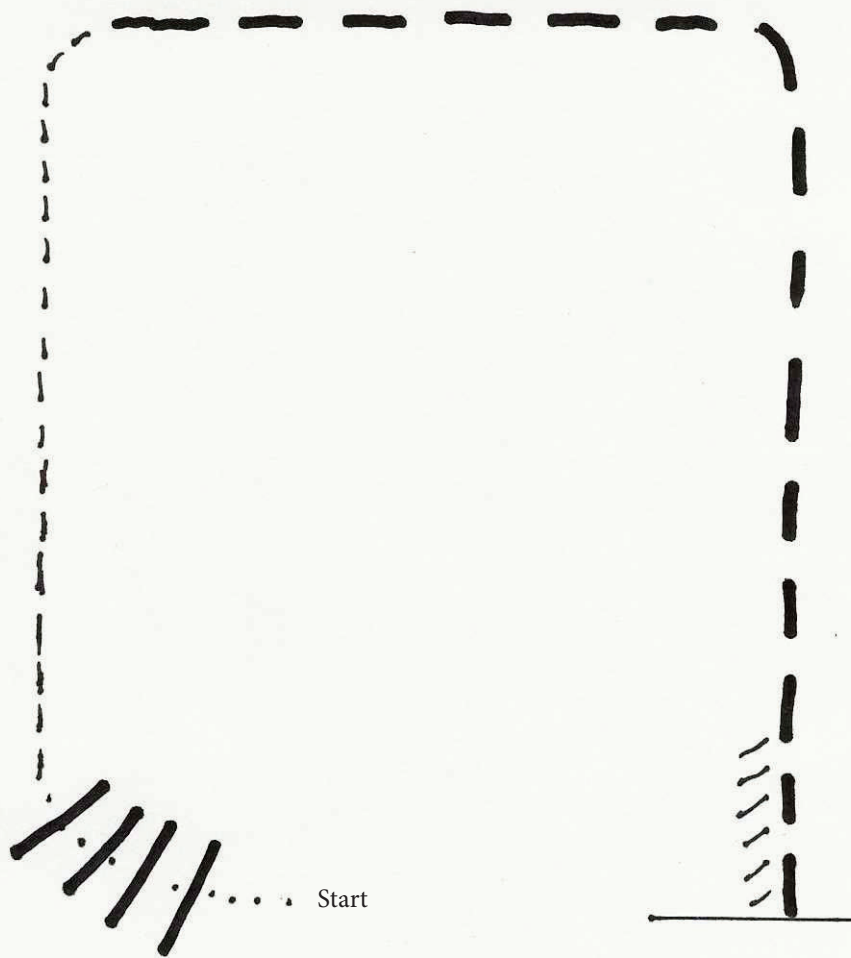

12. Side pass right

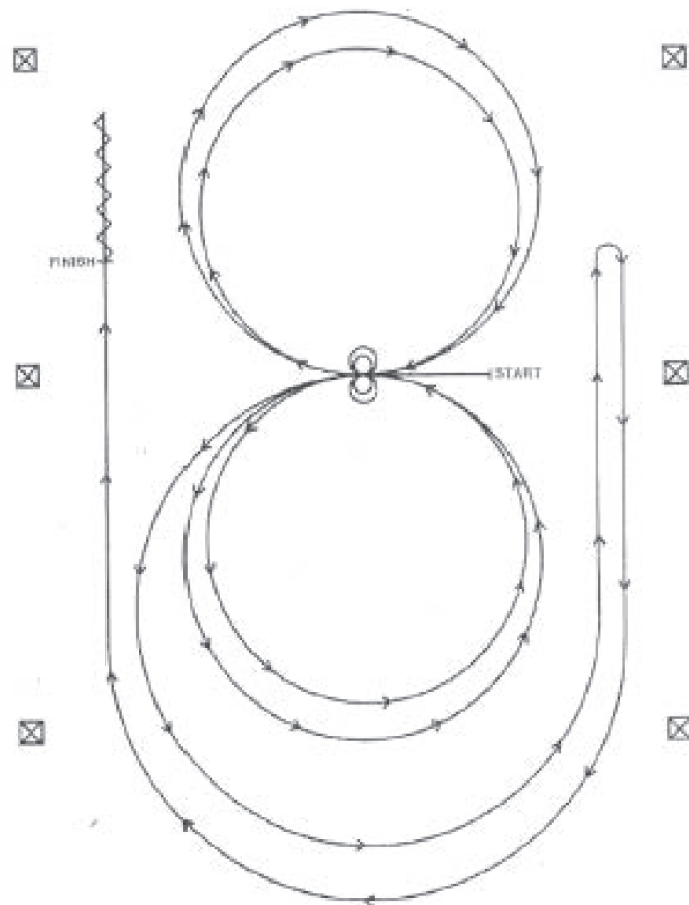

174. Pattern K – Level II and III Reining (NRHA Pattern A)
(8-13; 14-18; 19 & Over)



Horses may walk or trot to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting the pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the left lead, complete two circles to the left. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
2. Complete two spins to the left. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right lead, complete two circles to the right. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
4. Complete two spins to the right. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the left lead, go around the end of the arena, run down the right side of the arena past center marker, stop and roll back right.
6. Continue around the end of the arena to run down the left side of the arena past the center marker. Stop. Back up.
