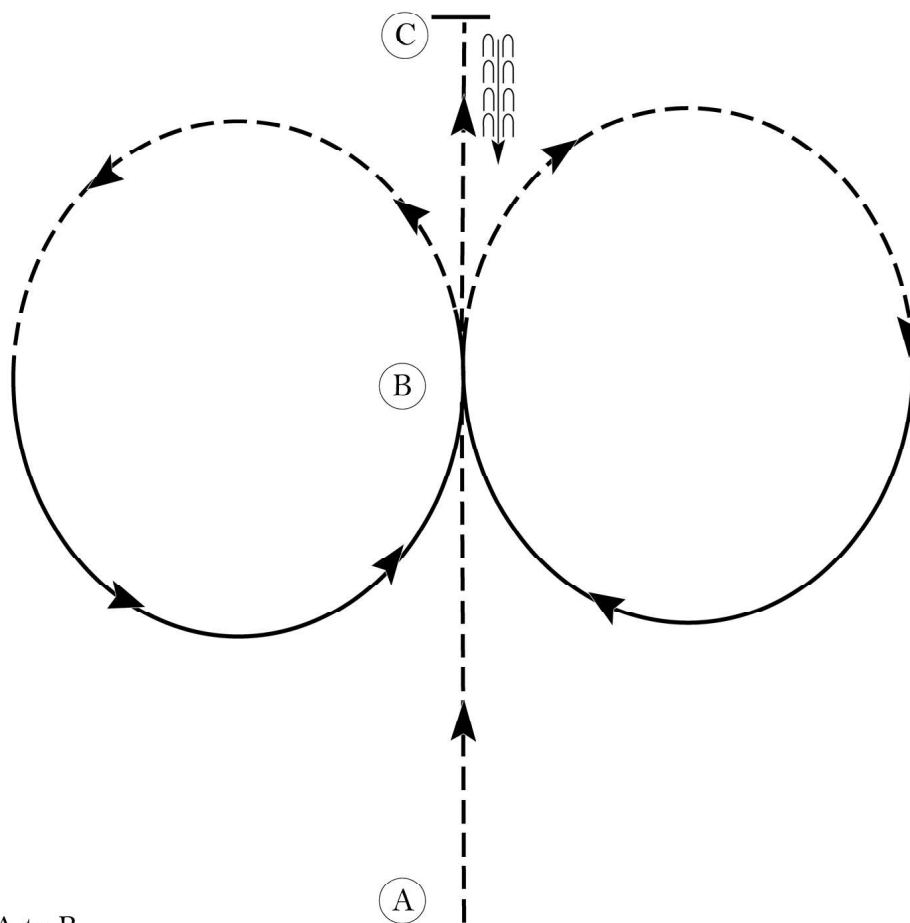

Show Date: 04-25-2026



1. Sitting trot A to B
2. At B posting trot on the left diagonal in a half circle.
3. Canter on the right lead back to B. .
4. Posting trot on the right diagonal in a half circle.
5. Canter on the left lead back to B.
6. Sitting trot to C.
7. Stop at C and back approximately one horse length.

Exit at a sitting trot.

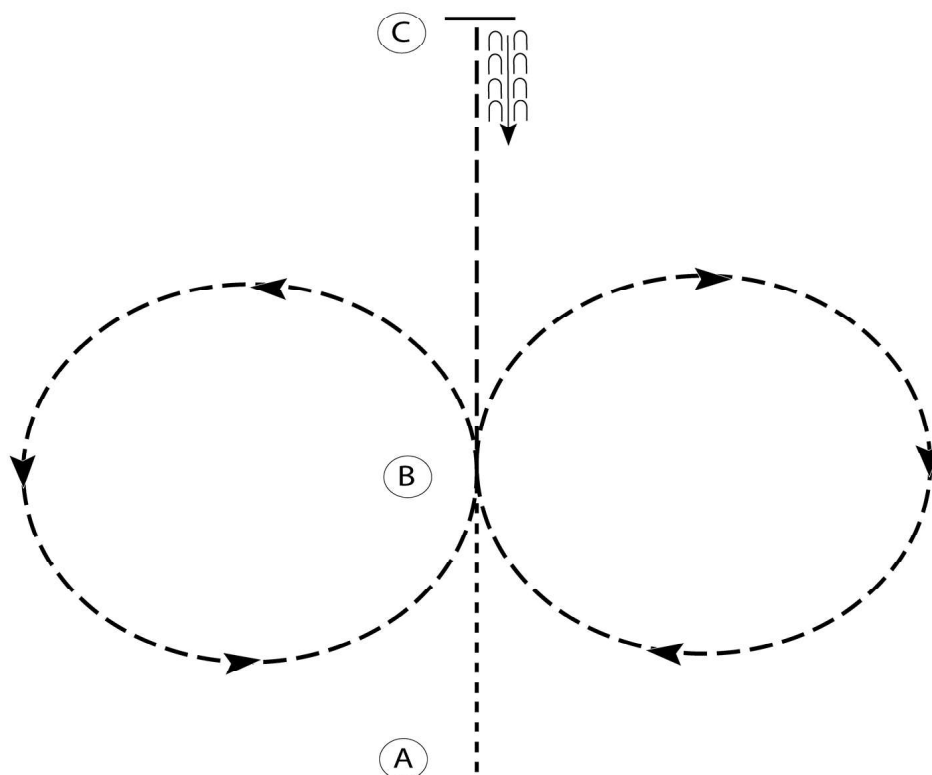

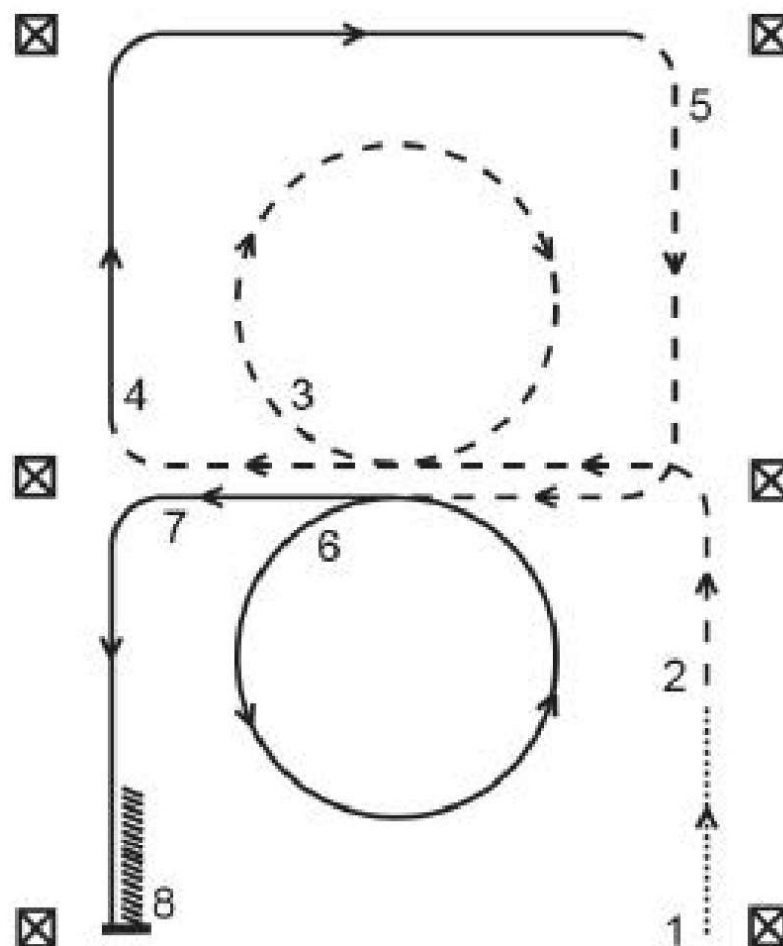
1. Walk A to B.

3. At B posting trot a circle to the left on the proper diagonal. (Right Diagonal)
4. At B sitting trot to C.
5. At C stop and back approximately one horse length.

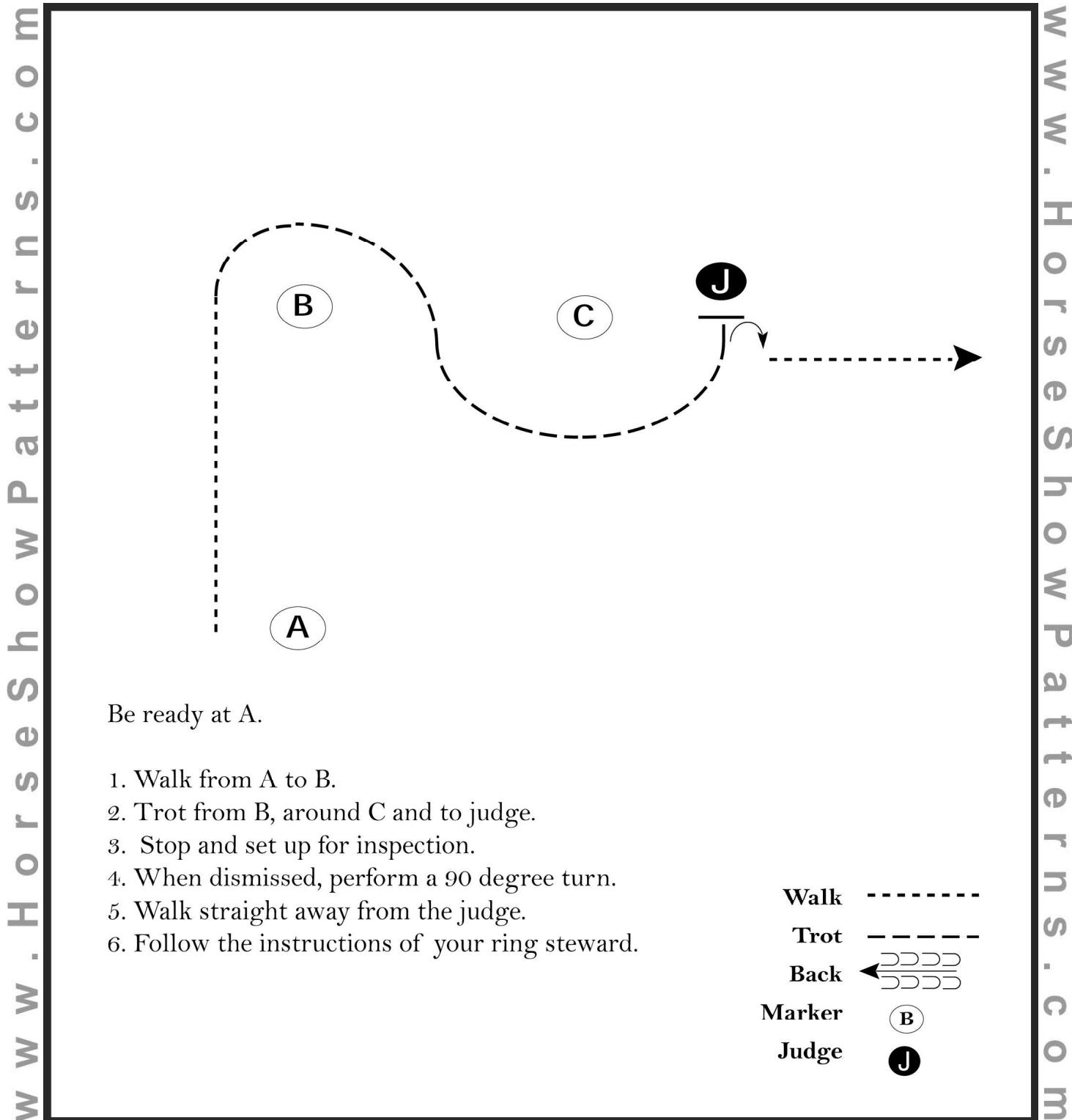
1. Normal walk.
2. Rising trot halfway between cones.
3. Change diagonals then circle right, rising trot.
4. Canter right lead.
5. Sitting trot.
6. Canter left lead, circle left.
7. Continue canter left lead.
8. Halt and back one horse length.

Leave arena on a loose rein at the free walk.

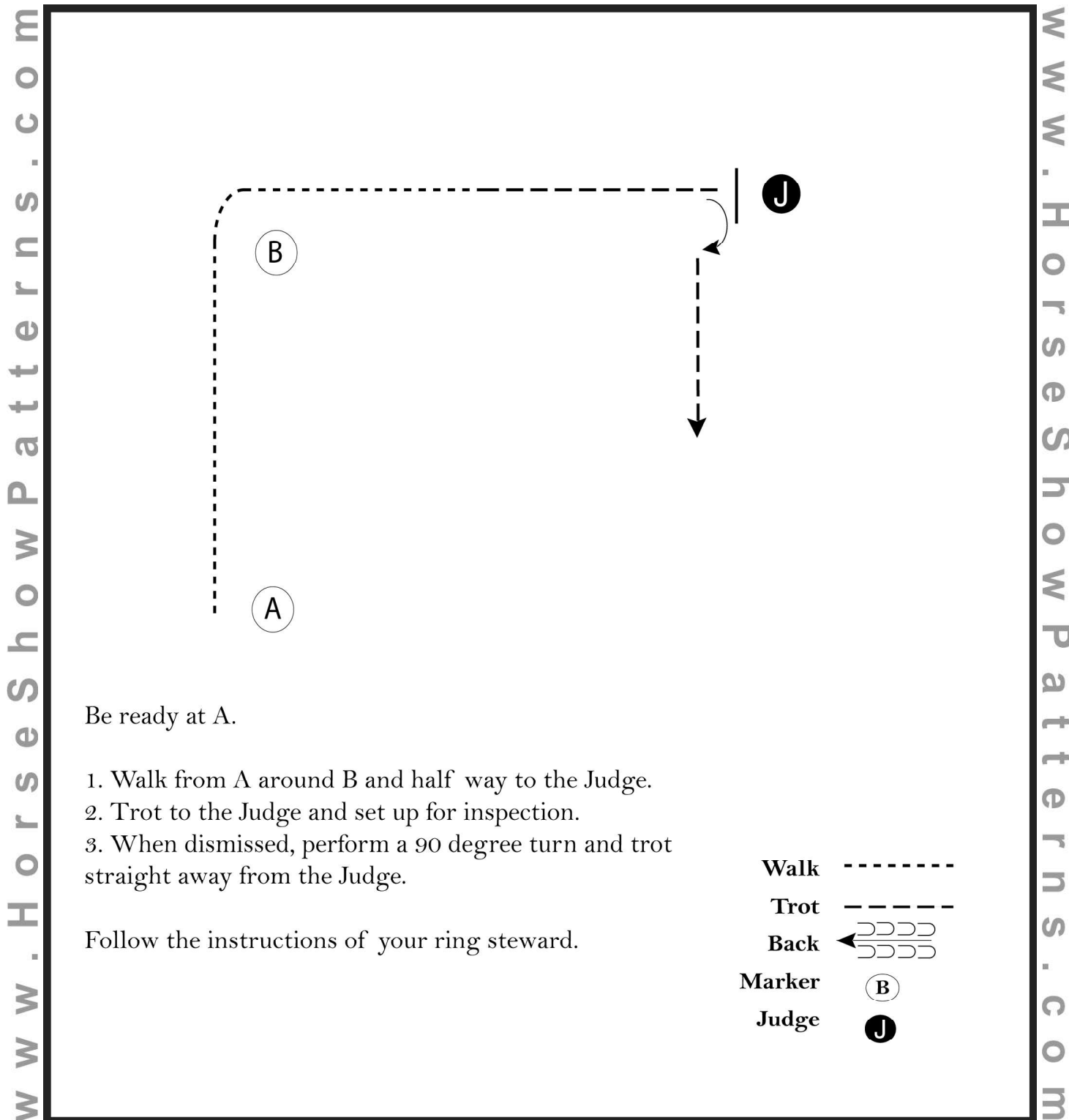

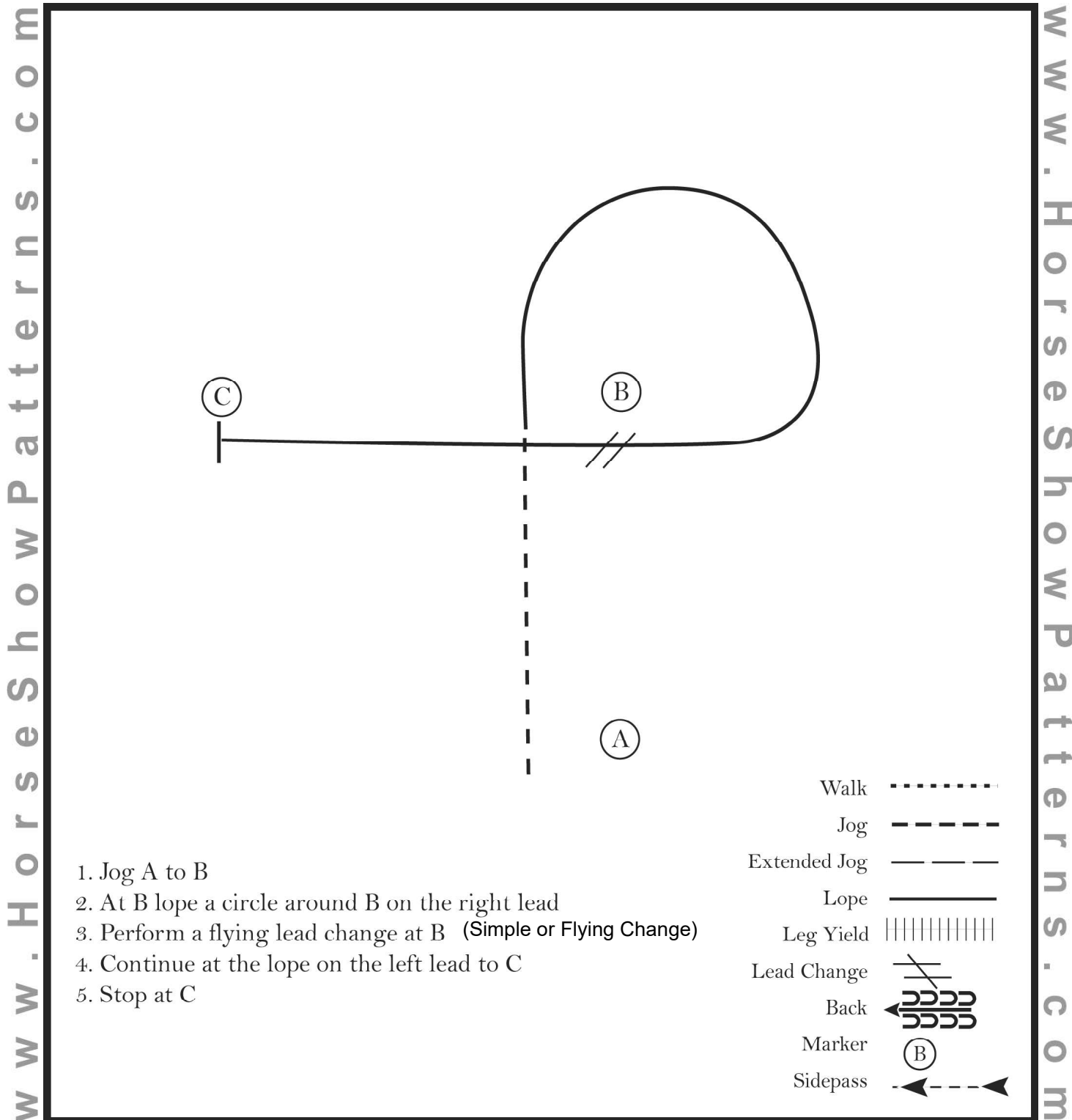

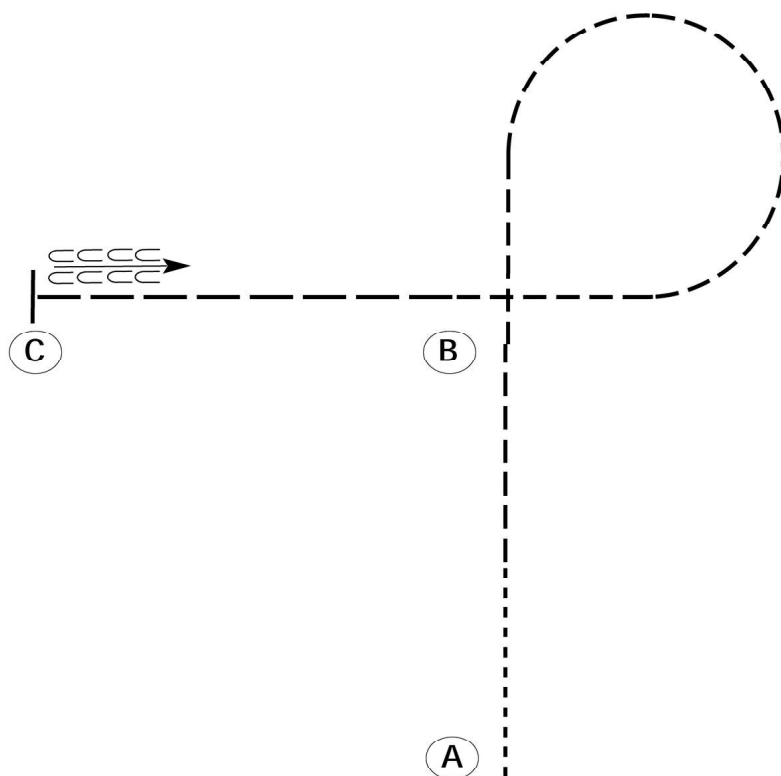

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Be ready at A.

1. Walk from A 1/2 way to B.
2. Jog the rest of the way to B.
3. Jog a circle to the right.
4. Extend the jog from B to C.
5. Stop at C and back one horse length.

Retire to the rail or line up at a jog.

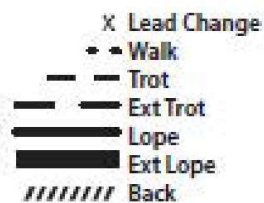
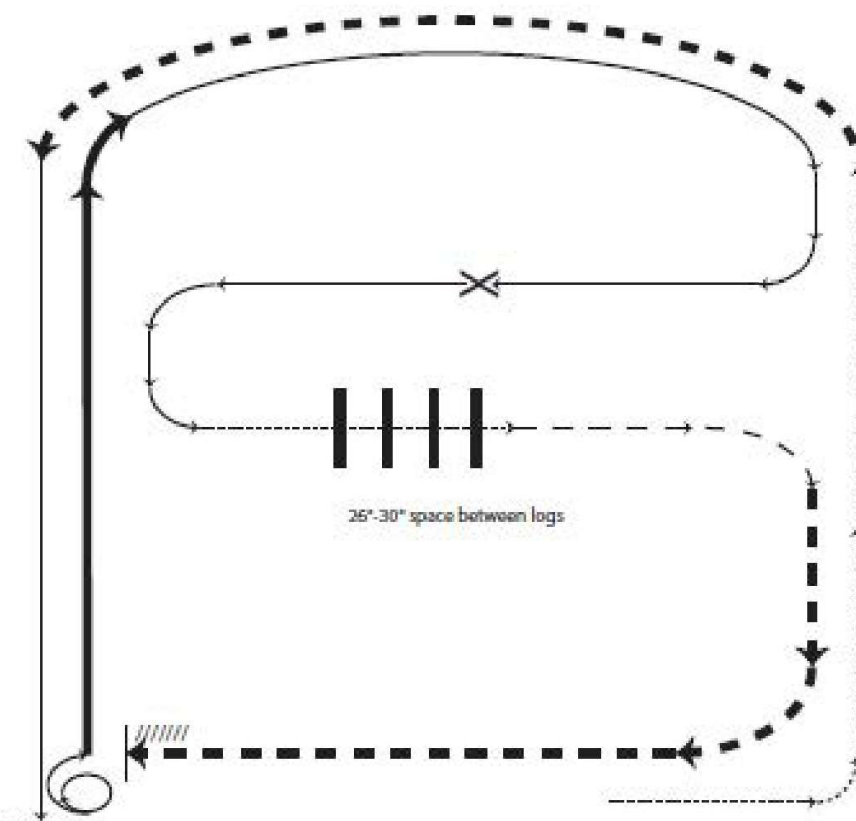

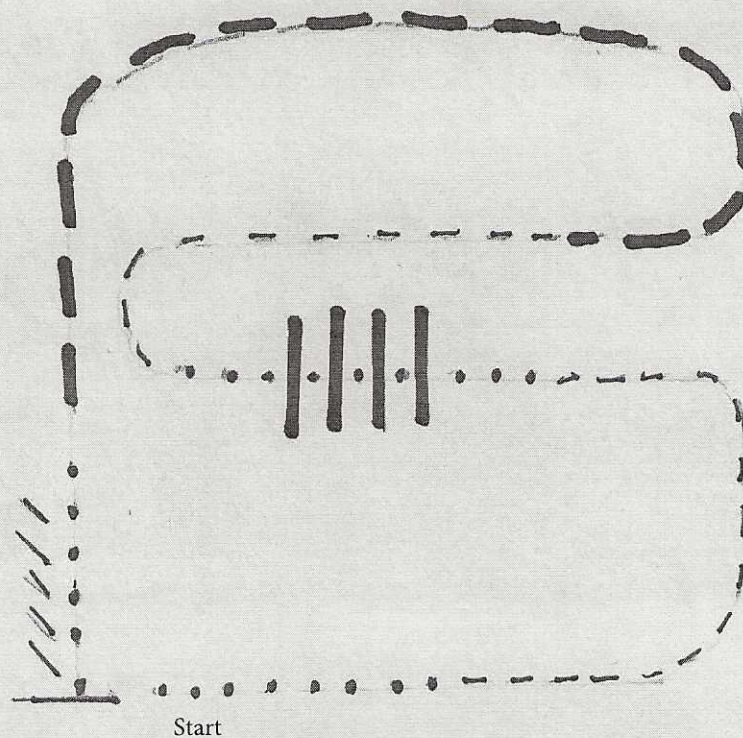

363. Pattern 2 – Ranch Riding (8-13; 14-18; 19 and Over)



1. Walk
2. Trot
3. Extended trot
4. Left lead lope
5. Stop, 1 1/2 turn right
6. Extended lope
7. Collect to working lope right lead
8. Change leads (simple or flying)
9. Walk
10. Walk over logs
11. Trot
12. Extended trot
13. Stop and back

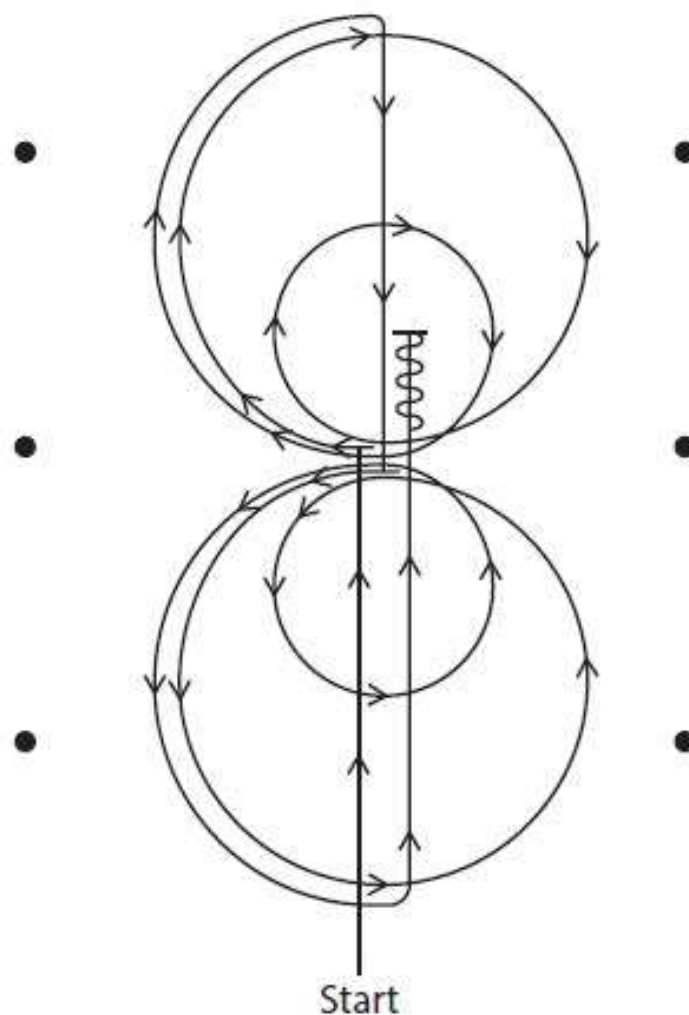

2. Trot
3. Walk before the poles.
4. Walk over the poles.
5. Trot
6. Extend Trot
7. Walk
8. Stop

Back:  Jog:  Lope: 

Proper execution of this pattern requires Level I Advancement skills. All stops are balanced. (Sliding stops are permitted)

1. Lope to center of arena and halt at center marker.
2. 90 degree turn to the left.
3. Lope a large circle to the right followed by a small circle to the right.
4. Continue around previous large circle, at the top of the circle, run down the middle to the center marker and halt.
5. 90 degree turn to the right.
6. Lope a large circle to the left followed by a small circle to the left.
7. Continue around previous large circle, at the top of the circle, run down the middle past the center marker, halt and back at least ten feet.
