Eligibility Requirements

If you are a Florida East Coast ABC member general contractor or subcontractor, you are eligible to compete.

Joint ventures are eligible if one firm is an ABC member. Entries must originate from a current ABC member.

Subcontractors may enter a project even if the GC is not a current ABC-FEC member.

Completion Date: The project entered must be completed (e.g., Certificate of Occupancy issued) between May 1, 2024 and May 30, 2025. Projects that won ABC awards in previous years are not eligible except in the case of substantial renovation or additions.

Award Categories

Eagle Awards - One first place Eagle Award will be presented for each category.

Pyramid Awards - One runner-up Pyramid Award will be presented for each category.

Eagle Award and Pyramid Award winners will be highlighted in the multimedia presentation at the Awards Banquet.

Special Awards

Specialty Contractor of the Year Award of Excellence – The highest scoring specialty contractor project will be presented this special award at the Awards Banquet. Winner is announced at the Awards Banquet.

Free Enterprise - One award will be given to the GC with the greatest percentage of ABC-FEC members (subcontractors, suppliers and associate members) working directly on the project entered into the competition.

Project of the Year - A single project submitted by a general contractor which best exemplifies the contributions of quality construction will be chosen as the Project of the Year. This project will be announced at the Awards Banquet.

The George Cuesta Architect of the Year Award -All architectural firms listed on GC applications of winning projects will be considered for this award which is selected through a survey sent to Florida East Coast Chapter members.

Young Professionals Award - One award will be given to the project with exceptional use of young professionals.

Technology Award - One award will be given to the project with the most innovative use of technology.

Awards Banquet

Award winners will be invited to a formal presentation of their awards at the ABC Excellence in Construction Awards Banquet to be held in October 2025. All winners will be featured in the Excellence in Construction Awards magazine distributed at the Awards Banquet and to the South Florida community.

National Excellence in Construction Awards

Eagle and Pyramid winning projects will be eligible to be entered in the National ABC Excellence in Construction competition. Any project with a safety related fatality is ineligible for National EIC Awards.

Judging of Projects

All projects are offered the opportunity to do a presentation (up to 15 minutes) for the team of judges at the ABC office on the same day that your category is judged. Presentations are optional, but encouraged.

Project Scoring

Judging criteria include jobsite and project conditions, difficulty of installation, complexity, project coordination, exterior, mechanical, electrical, interior finishes, safety, and quality of finished product. Projects will be judged from application information, descriptions, testimony, and photographs. Winners will be notified in advance of the Awards Banquet.

Instructions

All entries must be received by ABC no later than May 30, 2025.

Project Entry Fee: \$500

Entries must be submitted with a completed entry form and the entry fee. There is no limit to the number of entries in any category, nor is there any limit to the number of projects that each member company may submit.

Entry Requirements

- 1. Completed "Intent to Enter Project" online form by April 1, 2025 at
- 2. Completed entry form by May 30, 2025.
- 3. Paid project entry fee (can be paid via credit card online or company check sent to ABC-FEC office).
- 4. Name, email, and cell phone number of person providing presentation to judges.

NOTE: If this is undetermined at time of entry, provide point person to coordinate. In-person presentations not required.

- 5. The following are required and must be submitted via Dropbox link. (Provided by ABC FEC. See page 7 for instructions.)
 - a. Digital photos of the project at various stages if possible at the highest resolution available.
 - NOTE: If project wins an Eagle Award, one photo is used for the EIC magazine and up to six photos will be used in the evening's Powerpoint presentation. At least four different photos should be included (maximum of ten). If photos do not meet specifications, they will not be used for publication or for the program.
- b. Provide a profile description of the project included in the awards presentation (60 words or 350 characters or less).
- c. GC's ONLY Provide a comprehensive digital list of subcontractors who worked on the project as a MS Excel spreadsheet. Must include company name, scope, contact person name, phone number, and email address. (This is one factor used to determine the Free Enterprise Award.) Failure to provide this information will result in a deduction of points on overall score.

Qualifications

- 1. All entries become the property of the Associated Builders and Contractors, Florida East Coast Chapter, Inc. and may be used for publication or any other promotional purpose ABC deems appropriate.
- 2. EIC Awards Committee reserves the right to reassign the category if it believes the submission was improperly categorized.
- 3. The Awards Committee has set judging criteria. Selection of judges is at the discretion of the Awards Committee, and the results of the scoring of individual projects will remain *confidential*. The decision of the Awards Committee regarding criteria, selection of judges, classification of projects and selection of winning projects is final.

Provide a description of your scope for this project with the following information: type of construction your company performed, size of project, your contract value, length of project, and percentage of labor that is self-performed.

Narrative Why your company deserves an award. Include written narrative. (Upload to your project Dropbox.) Provide information indicating why this project is special and why it qualifies for an award. Describe innovative programs, special obstacles, and customized work.

Presentations will be judged on an assigned date between June 17 and July 31, 2025. Most judging is scheduled between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. After all entries are submitted and a schedule is created, the contact person listed on the entry form will be notified.
