

NAS Gulf Research Program

- A grant workshop and the upcoming funding opportunity on Community Resilience will be covered in an informational webinar on February 14, 2018. In July 2018, NAS will open a grant opportunity, Thriving Communities 5, focused on enhancing community resilience and well-being in the Gulf of Mexico region. In advance of this, NAS is hosting a Networking and Idea Development Workshop to connect potential applicants, encourage collaboration, and help cultivate innovative ideas for applying to the grant opportunity. Applications to participate in the workshop will be accepted through March 8, 2018. The grant is anticipated for release in July.
- NAS has two grant opportunities open. The Capacity Building Grants: Education and Scientific Research Disaster Recovery Grants: Cycle 2, are accepting applications.
- Applications are now open for our two fellowship opportunities: Early-Career Research Fellowships and Science Policy Fellowships. The Early-Career Research Fellows receive two years' worth of unrestricted funding to pursue the innovative research and unique collaborations that move coastal science forward. Applications are due by February 21, 2018. The Science Policy Fellows gain first-hand experience at the interface of science and policy as they spend one year alongside decision-makers at agencies across Alabama, Louisiana, Mississippi, Texas, and Florida. Applications are due by March 14, 2018.
