



MARSH ISLAND RANCH RETREAT

A 160-acre restored wetland sanctuary on the California–Oregon border, created by renowned wildlife photographer Tupper Ansel Blake and Madeleine Graham Blake. Once an overgrazed cattle ranch, it is now a thriving refuge for waterfowl, surrounded by 60,000 acres of Lower Klamath Lake National Wildlife Refuge.

With a lodge, historic cabins, and sweeping views of Mount Shasta and the Cascades, Marsh Island Ranch is a private retreat where wildlife, wilderness, and timeless beauty come together.
