## Notable moments in August

- **Aug. 20, 1619:** People born in Africa were captured, enslaved, and then transported to England's Jamestown Colony, noted as the beginning of the enslavement of Africans in the English colonies, which would later become the United States
- **Aug. 28, 1789:** Enslaved people in Martinique petition for their independence.
- **Aug. 15-19, 1845:** The National Convention of Colored Citizens was held in Buffalo. There, Henry Highland Garnet gave his speech, "An Address to the Slaves of the United States," in which he called for open rebellion.
- **Aug. 21-22, 1850:** Frederick Douglass chaired The Fugitive Slave Law Convention.
- **Aug. 10, 1858:** Anna Julia Cooper was born.
- **Aug. 1, 1920:** Marcus Garvey held The Universal Negro Improvement Association's first international convention.
- **Aug. 24, 1945:** Marsha P. Johnson was born.
- **Aug. 28, 1955:** Emmett Till was murdered in Money, Miss. His mother Mamie Till-Mobley famously made sure that Till would have an open casket funeral, saying, ""I wanted the world to see what they did to my baby."
- **Aug. 28, 1963:** Hundreds of thousands of people participated in The March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom, making it the largest demonstration on the Capitol in the nation's history.
- **Aug. 22, 1964:** Fannie Lou Hamer, representing the Mississippi Freedom Democratic Party, spoke before the Democratic Party's convention credentials committee, detailing her story about trying to register to vote in Mississippi.
- **Aug. 11, 1965:** The Watts uprising began.
- **Aug. 18, 1971:** local and federal authorities conducted an early morning raid on the Republic of New Afrika's compound in Jackson, Miss.
- **Aug. 9, 2014:** The Ferguson uprising began.
