Our Safety Team is kicking off 2024 with a mission to make our church safer through the efforts of all parishioners. We welcome our newest member Ahmad Ward and hope that other volunteers join our team. If there is an interest or you have questions, please send a note to jimmcguffey37@gmail.com or Mike Miranda at Mirandainc64@yahoo.com.

One of the most important safety measures that most if not all consultants agree on, is that increasing parishioners/employee's awareness of security is the most cost-effective action that can be taken to improve safety at their location. This action is a top priority for our safety team. We are asking everyone to become involved in safety by reporting suspicious activities to the local police/911 or a safety team member. We recommend a safety awareness session for church members and leaders and are looking for volunteers to join the team.

Our members and their contact information will be shared along with this communication.

A few suspicious activities are noted below and there are others which will be discussed later:

- A person(s) sitting in a vehicle observing our location, especially when events are held, especially if you see a confederate flag or MAGA or other cult like stickers.
- Perhaps you hear or learn of a threat related to our church.
- The same person(s) or vehicles are sighted near our church multiple times when events are being held at our church but there are no other nearby events being held.
- Person(s) with cameras taking photos of areas that tourists would not normally be interested in capturing.
