National Honor Society

This application is for current **sophomores** and **juniors**. Juniors who were accepted into the National Honor Society in the fall are reminded that they must reapply. Any senior who has not been accepted into the National Honor Society and would like to apply should speak with Mr. Acri.

Requirements

- All students are reminded that to qualify for NHS, they must meet all four pillars that NHS is built on: *Scholarship, Service, Character, and Leadership*. All students must exemplify the characteristics of a Vir Fidelis and utilize their tools within the Monsignor Farrell community.
- Applicants must have a cumulative average of no less than 90 and no subject grade below 80.
- Applicants must have a minimum of 10 hours of **in school service**. This includes participation in the Usher Society, Book Store, State Textbook Office, Altar Servers, Lectors, Lab Assistants, etc. List what school service you performed and the number of hours completed. A signature from **each moderator is required next to each listing on page 3**.
- Applicants must have a minimum of 10 hours of **community service (out of school)**. This includes, but is not limited to, participation in church activities, assisting with snow shoveling, volunteering at food pantries, or assisting with youth sports. List what community service you have performed, and the number of hours completed. A **signature from a supervisor is required next to each listing on page 3**.
- One of the pillars of the National Honor Society is character. All applicants who wish to be accepted must have an exemplary disciplinary and attendance record.

Please attach a copy of your report card **and** a printout of your grades from your PowerSchool account. Both should be neatly stapled to the application. **Write the number of absences you have this year on the bottom right corner of your report card.** You can find this information on PowerSchool.

All materials must be handwritten and submitted in a sealed envelope with your name and homeroom on the front. **Neatness will be taken into consideration.** If the application and submitted material cannot be read, the application **will not be** considered.

Completed applications must be brought to the Main Office and placed in the NHS application box **no later than Monday, March 23rd**.

Please understand that membership in the National Honor Society will require weekly sessions as a mentor in our Center for Learning and Academic Wellness (CLAW). Failure to complete these expectations can jeopardize your NHS membership. NHS status will be continuously monitored. Students must continue to meet all four pillars to avoid losing their NHS membership.

The National Honor Society induction Ceremony is scheduled for Thursday, April 23rd, at 6:30 pm at Monsignor Farrell. **Students who are accepted into the National Honor Society will be notified via email.**
