NOTICE OF EMERGENCY AMENDMENTS

- 5) Effective Date of Emergency Rule: March 20, 2020
- 6) If this emergency rulemaking is to expire before the end of the 150-day period, please specify the date on which it is to expire: This emergency rule will expire at the end of 150 days or the date on which the disaster proclaimed by the Governor in Gubernatorial Proclamation number 2020-038 issued on March 9, 2020 terminates, whichever occurs first.
- 7) Date filed with the Index Department: March 20, 2020
- 8) A copy of the Emergency Amendment, including any material incorporated by reference, is on file in the Agency's principal office and is available for public inspection.
- 9) Reason for Emergency: Due to COVID-19 outbreak, employers are looking for employees to work 7 days or more in a week to keep up with customer demand.
- 10) A complete Description of the Subjects and Issues Involved: Under 820 ILCS 140, an employer cannot force an employee to work 7 days or more without a rest. These emergency rules would provide for an employer to seek volunteers amongst their employees to work 7 days or more. The employer would need to notify the Illinois Department of Labor.
- 11) Are there any rulemakings to the Part pending? No
- 12) Statement of Statewide Policy Objectives: This rulemaking does not create or enlarge a mandate as described in Section 3(b) of the State Mandates Act.
