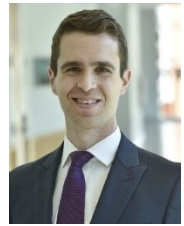

His recent projects analyze households' insurance contract decisions in the U.S. National Flood Insurance Program, the effects of Hurricane Sandy and Hurricane Harvey on the finances of businesses, and household and business use of the U.S. Federal Disaster Loan Program. Collier has published in the Journal of Risk and Insurance, Journal of Money, Credit, and Banking, and Harvard Business Review, among other outlets. He has been quoted and his research cited in the Wall Street Journal, Bloomberg, Business Insurance, American Banker, and the Actuarial Review.
