The results from our October digital PSAT should be available for most sophomores and juniors.

Standardized testing remains an important part of the college admissions process, so Athens Academy uses the PSAT in grades 10 and 11 to help prepare students to demonstrate the knowledge and skills they need to succeed in college.

Students can use their personal College Board student account to view their PSAT score report and additional insights online. Students who provided a mobile phone number during testing can view their scores on the [BigFuture School app](#) (if they don't already have one, students will need to [create a college board account and password](#) to be able to access their scores reports).

In the official score report PDF, students can view a graphic showing their performance on each of the eight skill areas measured on the PSAT (four in Reading and Writing and four in Math). Students can use this section to identify skill areas they may want to focus on to practice and improve.

Here are some ways students can develop each of the skills identified in their score report for focus and improvement:

- [Khan Academy](#) can help supplement this work with practice questions designed for each of these areas.
- Students can take practice tests in Bluebook and review the results on [My Practice](#) to learn more about what their practice scores mean.
- They can also build skills with the [SAT Question of the Day](#), which provides a gamified, interactive way to work on a Reading and Writing or Math question each day.
- Students can log in to their personal College Board account at studentscores.collegeboard.org to get their score reports and additional insights about their scores (juniors should have an account from last year).
