We begin our trip with a visit to the JFK Library and Museum, where the amazing story of our 35th comes alive. We will see his oval office, Jackie's beautiful gowns. and many artifacts from the 1960's. Next, it is on to historic Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market. Faneuil Hall was builtin 1840 and has served as a public meeting place ever since. In this edifice, Patriots of American Revolution met to discuss resistance to the British, Daniel Webster eulogized Thomas Jefferson and John Adam's anti-slavery meetings were held, and much more. The Quincy Market is filled with shops and over 40 restaurants for us to enjoy. **Hotel: Boston, MA**





Day 2- We start the day with a professionally guided city tour of Boston. After our tour, we travel to Plimoth Plantation, a recreation of a 17th century colonial village and Indigenous American village. You can stroll along and speak to the costumed docents, who are in character, so they only know events up to 1627. There are two unique gift shops you may visit. We end the day with a visit to Plymuoth Rock. **Hotel: Fall River, MA**







Day 4- We travel to Kennebunkport, a beautiful seaside port city of 3,474 inhabitants and the former summer home of George H.W. & Barbara Bush. You will have time to explore and shop in this beautiful village. Next, we travel to Portland, a city known for it's diversity of architecture and restaurants. You will have time on your own to explore this fascinating city before we head to the famous Portland Head Light. **Hotel: Bar Harbor, ME**

Day 5- This morning you will have free time to explore the many unique shops and attractions in Bar Harbor. In the afternoon, we will enjoy a fabulous 2 hour wildlife cruise before our group dinner in a local restaurant. **Hotel: Bar Harbor, ME**

Day 6- Acadia National Park is our destination for today. We tour this American treasure with a drive through the park an up to the top of Cadillac Mountain where we will have a breathtaking view of the forests covered in autumnal colors. **Hotel: Gorham, NH**





Day 7- Today, we go up to the top of Mt. Washington (6,288' elevation) on the oldest cog railroad in the world. On a clear day, you can see the Atlantic Ocean from the top (70 miles). Mt. Washington is one of the most unusual weather locations on earth. Our next stop is Woodstock, VT, the quintessence of a New England village with it's covered bridges and colonial homes. **Hotel: Manchester,VT**

Day 8- We visist the beautiful village of Manchester, VT and the Northshire Bookstore before driving to the Bennington Museum for a tour which includes a tour of the Revolutionary War Monument and the grave of renowned poet Robert Frost. **Hotel: Boston, MA**

Day 9- We fly home.
