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**Have you ever yearned to see the diverse and amazing animals of Africa in their native environment? Join us on this amazing tour that will take us to Tanzania for viewing animals, birds, and scenery in the Ngorongoro Crater and in the world famous Serengeti Plain.**

**1/19** - Fly to Tanzania

**1/20** - Your safari driver/guide will pick you from the airport and drive you to Ngarasero Mountain Lodge in Arusha. Arusha is one of the largest tourism hubs in Tanzania. **Hotel:** Ngarasero Mountain Lodge

**1/21** - Depart Arusha in the morning for Tarangire National Park. Upon arrival in Tarangire National Park, you will have an afternoon game drive. Tarangire National Park is 2,850 square kilometers (1,100 square miles) and has the greatest concentration of wildlife outside the Serengeti ecosystem. There are large herds of elephants, lions, wildebeests, zebras, buffalos, impalas, gazelles, hartebeests, waterbucks, elands, and a variety of birds. After your game drive, you will overnight at Tarangire Safari Lodge inside the park. **Hotel:** Tarangire Safari Lodge **Meals:** B/L/D

**1/22** - After our early morning breakfast we are ready for game driving out of Tarangire National Park. Our goal today is to arrive at the seemingly endless grasslands of the Serengeti. After having our picnic lunch we will be mesmerized with an afternoon game drive into this forest staged internationally for the famous wildebeest migration. We head to your lodge for overnight stay at Lake Ndutu Safari Lodge. **Hotel:** Lake Ndutu Safari Lodge **Meals:** B/L/D



**1/23** - After breakfast we will head out for a full day game drive in southern Serengeti National park. A striking characteristic of this area is the stunning acacia woodland, which is immediately surrounded by the short grass plains. Within this wooded area is Lake Ndutu, one of the Rift Valley's soda lakes. At the height of the wildebeest migration, and when heavy rains have fallen, often lines of wildebeest can be seen crossing the lake. Accompanying the wildebeest large numbers of zebra and Thomson gazelles. Also, the biggest concentration of big cats in the world (cheetahs, lions, leopards, etc.) **Hotel:** Lake Ndutu Safari Lodge **Meals:** B/L/D



**1/24** - After breakfast at your lodge, you will depart for central Serengeti with picnic lunch, enjoy game drive en route. You will go on an afternoon game drive in the central part of the Serengeti, where many different landscapes can be found; savanna with the big plains to the south, hills and woods to the west, the kopjes area to the east, and bushland to the north. Notable rivers (Seronera, Banagi and Grumeti) also run through the park. Many different species of mammals can be spotted during game drives, including elephants, buffalos, giraffes, antelopes, hippos and crocodiles. **Hotel:** Serengeti Serena Lodge **Meals:** B/L/D

**1/25** - You will spend this entire day in the Serengeti exploring different parts of the park in search of game. Game drives are dependent on the wildlife migration patterns. Natural habitats include savanna grasslands dotted with acacia trees, magnificent rock outcroppings called kopjes, swamps, dense bush as well as streams and rivers. The different habitats provide different opportunities for tracking different animal species. Late afternoon, you will be driven back to the lodge for the night. **Hotel:** Serengeti Serena Lodge **Meals:** B/L/D

**1/26** - After breakfast, we depart the lodge for a game drive in central Serengeti, then proceed to Olduvai Gorge, after lunch you will be driven to the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater for dinner. **Hotel:** Ngorongoro Serena Lodge **Meals:** B/L/D

**1/27** - This morning we have an early breakfast before departure for a game drive in the world renowned Ngorongoro Crater. For many, this wildlife spectacle is the pinnacle of their safari experience. The Ngorongoro Crater boasts all the 'Big 5', including a small population of endangered black rhino. The Ngorongoro Crater is the largest unbroken caldera in the world and is surrounded by very steep walls rising 610 m from the floor. The Ngorongoro Crater is an amazing haven for wildlife throughout the year due to the permanent availability of grass and water. After a picnic lunch in the Crater, we proceed with the game drive until evening then head to Lake Manyara Serena Lodge. **Hotel:** Lake Manyara Serenc Lodge **Meals:** B/L/D

**1/28** - This morning we will depart the lodge for Arusha for a city tour which will include the Maasai Market and Souvenir shopping. You will have lunch in Arusha followed by free time before transferring to Kilimanjaro Airport for our departure flight home. **Meals:** B/L

**1/29** - Arrive home
