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St. Patrick's Cathedral in Dublin

Day 1: Monday, May 17, 2027 • Departure
We depart Chicago for Dublin.

Day 2: Tuesday, May 18, 2027 • Arrive in Dublin, Ireland
Upon arrival we check into our hotel and meet our traveling companions for an afternoon orientation drive through statue-lined O'Connell Street and elegant Georgian squares to St. Patrick's Cathedral and Trinity College. We end the day with dinner at our hotel. **D**

Day 3: Wednesday, May 19, 2027 • Dublin–Downpatrick, Northern Ireland–Belfast

On our northbound route today, we pass Drogheda, scene of the Battle of the Boyne in 1690, then through the fertile landscape of the Boyne Valley, known for its prehistoric passage graves. We cross the border into Northern Ireland and drive past the Mountains of Mourne to Downpatrick, the burial place of Patrick, Ireland's Patron Saint. Next, we head to the vibrant city of Belfast, where the Titanic was built. We join a "living history" tour including a visit to the fascinating Titanic Exhibition. **(B,D)**

Day 4: Thursday, May 20, 2027 • Belfast–Giant's Causeway–Derry–Donegal–Sligo

First stop this morning is the Giant's Causeway, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Let the province's story unfold as we head for the city of Derry before returning to the Republic to visit Donegal, the ancient town founded by Danish Vikings and home of the O'Donnell Clan. We drive along Donegal Bay with its small fishing ports and hidden beaches before arriving

in Sligo, tonight's destination. **(B,D)**

Day 5: Friday, May 21, 2027 • Sligo–Knock–Galway–Cliffs of Moher–Ennis

Today we continue south to Knock, a village that has attracted pilgrims from all over the world since the townsfolk saw apparitions. We arrive for lunch in Galway, a popular seaside destination and a buzzing cosmopolitan center with cobblestone streets, colorful shops, and a busy café and bar culture. We cross the limestone plateau of The Burren to visit the spectacular 668-foot Cliffs of Moher. Tonight, we enjoy a medieval banquet at Bunratty Castle. **(B,D)**

Day 6: Saturday, May 22, 2027 • Ennis–Adare–Dingle Peninsula–Killarney

Skirting the city of Limerick, we head to Adare, a village known for its prize-winning thatched cottages. We delight in breathtaking scenery this afternoon on the Dingle Peninsula, where the 32-mile Sleat Head drive affords magnificent vistas of the Atlantic Ocean. We see the Blasket Islands and hear about the way of life and unique literary achievements of its inhabitants prior to their evacuation in 1953. The next two nights are spent in the popular resort of Killarney. **(B,D)**

Day 7: Sunday, May 23, 2027 • Killarney–Ring of Kerry–Killarney

At Killorglin, we join the road known as the "Ring of Kerry" for a 100-mile coastal panoramic drive: sparkling seascapes, mountains dotted with brightly colored farmhouses, winding lanes bordered with subtropical vegetation, and spectacular

views of the Lakes of Killarney from Ladies View. Next, we take a horse-drawn jaunting car along the national park lakeshore for pictures of Ross Castle back to Killarney. **(B,D)**

Day 8: Monday, May 24, 2027 • Killarney–Blarney–Waterford

More scenic splendor awaits us as we head over the Kerry Mountains into County Cork. We stop in Blarney, famous for its Stone of Eloquence, with time at our leisure to see the castle and shop for Irish crafts and handmade crystal. After lunch, we drive past Cork, the country's second-largest city. Youghal and Dungarvan are further milestones on our way to Waterford, where a guided tour of the House of Waterford Crystal is included. Before checking in at our hotel and dinner, we stop to partake in a traditional pub experience at a local favorite watering hole. **(B,D)**

Day 9: Tuesday, May 25, 2027 • Waterford–Enniscorthy–Avoca–Glendalough–Dublin

Highlights on our northbound journey today include Enniscorthy, site of the final battle of the Great Rebellion of 1798 and a visit to Ireland's oldest handweaving mill at Avoca. We enjoy views of the Wicklow Mountains and Glendalough with its ruins of a center of Irish Christianity, founded by St. Kevin. Back in Dublin tonight, we celebrate the success of our tour with dinner out on the town. **(B,D)**

Day 10: Wednesday, May 26, 2027 • Dublin

After breakfast we visit Trinity College and the Old Library to view the ancient Book of Kells, the manuscript of the four gospels in Latin on vellum dating back to the year 800. Next, we visit the wonderful National Museum of Ireland at Collins Barracks, a converted (and historic) housing area for the Irish military until the 1990's. Nearby is the Guinness Brewery Museum and Hop Store. After viewing the displays that chronicle a humble beginning over 200 years ago of brewing at St James Gate, we finally have a chance for a taste. We have the remainder of the day free to purchase last-minute souvenirs or explore a final time on our own. **(B,D)**

Day 11: Thursday, May 27, 2027 • Return to USA

Our vacation ends with breakfast this morning. Then we transfer to the airport for the return flight home. We return with great memories of a fantastic tour of the Emerald Isle, and the smiles and embraces of new friends. **(B)**

Payment Schedule:

A deposit of \$500 per person is due with reservation. Final payment is due 100 days prior (Feb. 6, 2027) to departure date. Invoice will be sent out prior to final payment. Passengers may add after this date subject to air and land availability. Generally airlines do not increase the price of a ticket after it has been contracted. However, prior to the issuance of a ticket, airlines may (and regularly do) impose fuel, tax, or security surcharges. In the event a surcharge is imposed after Ed-Ventures has received a final payment, Ed-Ventures will send an additional invoice for the surcharge amount. Early registration is encouraged.

Currency:

Currency exchange rates fluctuate constantly. In the event of a significant drop in the value of the dollar, we reserve the right to add a currency surcharge to the price of the tour.

Refund/Cancellation Policy:

All cancellations must be in writing. The date of postmark will determine the amount of refund due. Refunds are based on the number of days prior to departure date. From the time of deposit to 99 days before departure a \$100 administrative fee plus any airfare penalties will be assessed. From Final payment due date until 46 days before departure, a \$500 cancellation penalty plus lost airfare deposits and any unrecoverable deposits to ground suppliers will be assessed. Airline tickets once purchased are nonrefundable. Anyone canceling 45 days or less prior to departure will receive **no refund**.
