In this new learning environment, the Power2 Summit planning committee encourages proposals from individuals, school teams, educational organizations and other stakeholders which share their experience in this new environment and highlight the impact of youth voice and youth-adult partnership in education.

Preference is given to presentations co-facilitated by youth and adults.

Successful proposals will address one or more of these questions:

- What does it look and sound like when young people use their voices and partner with adults as they shape their educational experience?
- What does it look and sound like when young people - in partnership with adults - speak out on issues of social justice and sustainability?
- What are our next steps to cultivate youth-adult relationships in our school and community ensuring that power, responsibility, and joy in learning and decision making are shared equitably?
- What are our next steps to elevate youth voice and foster youth-adult partnership on issues of social justice and sustainability in our communities?

This is an excellent opportunity for youth and adult partnership teams to share their work, their stories, and their ideas for the future.

Sharing Sessions will be 45-minutes in length and conducted online.
