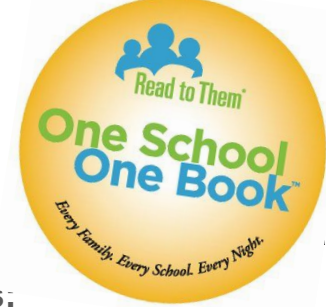




March Is Reading Month

Week 2: Chapters 7-12



Discussion Questions:

- “Every-Other Fridays made Bat uncomfortable, like his skin was on too tight.” (p. 35-36) Have you ever had that skin-too-tight feeling? What makes you feel that way?
- What is the name of the class bunny? The bunny is for when you need a cuddle. Do you have something you like to cuddle with? How does it make you feel? When are the times you need the most cuddles?
- How would you describe Mr. Grayson, Bat’s teacher? Compare him to your teacher. How are they the same? What is different about them?

Weekly Activity Ideas:

- Bat really likes patterns and does not like when they are broken. Go on a search for patterns and then collect and present them in some manner.
- Choose a location or setting from the book and create that location using as many details as possible.
- A kit is a skunk baby and a puppy is a baby dog? What is a baby kangaroo called? Research animals from around the world and see what their babies are called. Add some other interesting facts too.
