<u>Eligibility:</u> A student in good standing who is a St. Anthony of Padua Parishioner in grades 5th - 7th may apply for the scholarship.

<u>Criteria</u>: The following will be considered when selecting a recipient of the scholarship:

- Financial need
- Academic performance (a GPA of 3.0 or above)
- Student behavior
- Leadership/school involvement
- Stewardship/community service

<u>Application process</u>: All interested parties must complete the attached application and student reflection by **Friday**, **April 22**, **2022**.

A committee will review applications and make a decision of the scholarship recipient by the last day of school.
