Rotary Club of Eureka Awards \$2,000 Grant to Benefit Local Students and Families

EUREKA, Calif. — The Rotary Club of Eureka has awarded a \$2,000 grant to Eureka City Schools for the upcoming school year. This funding will help supply durable backpacks for middle and high school students at the annual Back to School Resource Fair in August.

Last year, more than 300 students received essential school supplies through this program, but not all were able to take home a backpack. Thanks to this grant, approximately 90 students will receive new, high-quality backpacks designed to last the entire school year, easing the financial strain on local families.


This program, conducted in partnership with the Marshall Family Resource Center, will also host two resource fairs, a holiday food giveaway, and maintain stocked resource closets at each school site.

The Rotary Club of Eureka regularly supports local initiatives in youth services, senior support, community health, literacy, and homelessness.
