

North Coast Tsunami Drill

March 26th, 2025 at 11 am

On March 26th, at 11 am, the Offices of Emergency Services in Del Norte, Humboldt, and Mendocino counties will issue test alerts encouraging the public to practice their earthquake and tsunami plans by:

If you are in the tsunami zone on March 26th - practice your evacuation plan by walking out of the tsunami zone.

If you are not in the tsunami zone on March 26th - stay put! You do not need to evacuate. However, take time to think about what you would do after a damaging earthquake.

Everyone - Remember that dangerous tsunami waves can last a long time; 24-48 hours after the first wave. In a real event, don't enter the tsunami hazard area until you receive notice that it is safe to do so.
