

The new SHRINE 3.0 interface is designed for a simpler, more straightforward user experience, making ACT more accessible to novice and non-expert users. Both the SHRINE 3.0 and the legacy web clients are available for use. Though both web clients will continue to be supported by ACT, the new web client will be the preferred pathway for newer users.

The below screen shots will give you a preview of what to expect with the new interface.

1. On View Results tab, users will see...

2. A list of their previous queries from all web clients used.

3. Clicking on a query reveals...

4. ...the criteria for the selected row,

5. A max number of patients in the network matching the user-selected criteria, and

6. The status or results of all nodes in the network.

1. Browse and search concepts defined by the ontology...

2. Date ranges

3. Occurrences

4. Lab test values...

5. ...then select or create a topic

6. Enter a name, and

7. Click Count Patients
