

Dr. Leslie Fox is the Director for Early Childhood Mental Health, Development and Disabilities programs at WestEd. She is responsible for project development, oversight and evaluation of cross-sector early childhood policies and practices intended to improve learning, health and developmental outcomes for infants, toddlers and preschoolers. Dr. Fox joined WestEd after working at the US Department of Education's Office of Special Education Programs where she provided monitoring and technical assistance to state agencies implementing the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). She is a nationally recognized expert in program evaluation and systems alignment, evidence-based practices to improve learning and developmental outcomes, and implementation science. Dr. Fox has led and supported early childhood research studies on inclusive communities, executive functions, Part C home visiting, and Autism Spectrum Disorders. She has 30+ years supporting the implementation of evidence-based and promising practices in home, school, early learning and childcare environments. For 20 years Dr. Fox worked with families and caregivers through home-visiting services on behalf of Part C/Early Intervention, Early Head Start and New Parent Support/Infant Mental Health programs.

Since 1999 Dr. Fox has held academic appointments teaching, supervising and mentoring undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students pursuing careers in education and developmental psychology.

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
