Dr. Doyle attended Georgetown School of Medicine & completed her pediatric residency at Children's Hospital of Los Angeles. Since finishing her residency, she has practiced general pediatrics in multiple settings including as the medical director of several federally funded clinics in underserved areas of Los Angeles County, as a hospitalist and as a member of a suburban private practice. Dr. Doyle is presently the Associate Medical Director for Los Angeles County California Children's Services (CCS), a Title V program that case manages children with special health care needs, and has been a staff physician at the program's medical therapy units for over 19 years, where rehabilitative services for physically disabled children are delivered. Finally, she served in the past as an officer for the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) California Chapter 2 for 14 years.
