Lafayette, Ind. – August 2022 – The Art Museum of Greater Lafayette, in partnership with the City of West Lafayette, is bringing *Art on the Wabash* back to Tapawingo Park on Sunday, September 25, 2022, after a 2-year absence. An independent, out-of-region juror, has selected 42 regional artists for the 15<sup>th</sup> annual art fair. Set in West Lafayette's riverside Tapawingo Park, the fair brings art and nature together for a pleasurable day. Free family art activities will be offered by the Art Museum and the Art League.

Juried prizes for Best of Show, Second and Third Place will be awarded early in the day. Visitors will receive ballots to vote for their favorite artist and the People's Choice Award will be announced at 3:00.

Food and beverages will be made available by Peoples Brewing Company, Guac Box, Fuel Coffee Shop and Kona Ice. Live music will be performed in the pavilion by local musicians, Gabrielle Elise 10:30-11:30, Jessica Billey 12:30-1:30, and Lauren Grace 2:30-3:30.
