	Vehicle Walking Combined	Entries which are both vehicles and people walking. This category does not include entries in which a trailer is being pulled by the vehicle. No entry may be higher than 13 feet to clear power lines. Only two vehicles per entry.		
	Vehicle Entry	Entries which are only vehicles or have vehicles pulling a trailer with a static display and no personnel on the trailer or tow vehicle. No entry may be higher than 13 feet to clear power lines. Only two vehicles per entry.		
	Float Entry	Entries which include a self-contained and motorized traditional type of float or those which utilize a vehicle and trailer; may or may not have people walking. No entry may be higher than 13 feet to clear power lines.

Please read all of the Christmas Parade Rules and Regulations. Your entry form is acceptance of these rules. We reserve the right to remove units for failure to comply. Thank you for making the Lafayette – West Lafayette Christmas Parade a Success!

Waiver and Hold Harmless Agreement: THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between Lafayette-West Lafayette Development Corp. (hereinafter referred to as "Organizer") and (hereinafter referred to as
"Parade Entry").
WHEREAS, the Organizer is sponsoring the "Lafayette Christmas Parade" event (the "Event") to be held
December 3, 2022, in Lafayette, Indiana; and
WHEREAS, the Parade Entry will be participating during the Event; and
WHEREAS, the Organizer requires that Parade Entry hold Organizer harmless from and against any and all liability or claims arising from any damages or injuries to person or property of the Parade Entry, his employees,
agents, guests and invitees.
NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:
1. The Parade Entry acknowledges that he is an independent entry and is not an agent or employee of the Organizer
and is not in any manner affiliated with the Organizer.
2. The Parade Entry acknowledges, agrees and understands that Organizer shall in no way or manner be responsible
or liable for supervising or monitoring the Parade Entry or the participation of the Parade Entry during the Event.
3. The Parade Entry agrees to indemnify and save Organizer harmless from any and all claims for personal injury or property damage which arise out of the negligence or tortuous conduct of Parade Entry, his servants, employees,
or agents.
4. The Parade Entry herby releases Organizer and agrees to hold Organizer harmless from and against any and all claims, damages, charges, demands, obligations, recoveries, liabilities, loss, deficiencies, rights or action or causes
of action, of any kind, character, or description, whether accrued, absolute, contingent, known, unknown, or otherwise (including, without limitation, any and all penalties, interest, attorneys' fees and other costs and expenses
relating to any and all actions, suits, proceedings, demands, assessments and judgments), which pertain to, arise
out of, result from or relate to Parade Entry's participation in the Event.

Christmas Parade Rules & Regulations

Parade Theme: A Very Merry Main Street Saturday, December 3, 2022 5:30pm

Parade Route

The parade begins in Lafayette at the intersection 11^{th} and Main Streets and continues down Main Street to 2^{nd} Street.

Staging Directions

- 1. The person listed as the contact for the parade entry will be notified of their entry number, arrival time, and staging location a couple of days prior to parade day.
- 2. A **single** representative from each entry must check in at the registration table located at the corner of 10th and Elizabeth Streets. The representative will receive an entry number placard to be placed on the entry unit.
- 3. All parade entries must be in place at their staging location by 4:30pm.
- 4. The parade starts promptly at 5:30pm from the intersection of 11th and Main Streets. Entries will be moved from the staging area to the parade route by police officers and/or emergency management personnel.

Parade Disbursement

- 1. The parade route ends at the intersection of 2nd and Ferry Streets. Keep moving through the entire parade route to this intersection. You will be directed further by police officers and/or emergency management personnel.
- 2. Entries with children or those who need to remove portions of their entry may utilize areas along 3rd or 4th Street. You will be directed to these areas by public safety personnel at the end of the parade route. This work should be done quickly and then proceed back to the staging area for any lengthy work.
- 3. Those picking up children or participants are strongly encouraged to communicate the information in #2 above to parents of the children in your entry.

In The Event of a Parade Cancellation

- 1. In the event of cancellation, the Contact Name on the entry form will be notified. Refunds will be given at the request of the entrant.
- 2. There will be no rain date for this event.

General Rules & Regulations

- 1. All participants must display holiday spirit and shall incorporate the parade theme and lights in their music, costumes, and float design and decorations.
- 2. All Entries must check in upon arrival at the parade check-in station. The check-in station opens at 1:30 PM the day of the parade. All entries must be checked in by 4:30 pm.
- 3. ALL entries must display their number that was issued upon check-in, on the front left-hand side of the entry, such as the windshield.
- 4. Parade entries must not include a Santa Claus. There is only one Santa Claus in the parade, which will be the last parade entry.
- 5. For safety concerns, no candy or other handouts may be thrown from floats or vehicles. Walkers may give out free candy or handouts, but it must be handed out by a walker. Nothing may be given directly from nor thrown from vehicles or floats.
- 6. Each organization is to find its own sponsors, if needed.
- 7. A banner is suggested to identify your entry. It should list the name of your organization and who is supporting your entry. The banner should precede the float and use large letters and be lighted.
- 8. All Parade Entries must maintain a spacing of approximately 30 feet from the entry in front of them upon entering Main Street and throughout the parade route.
- 9. No entry may display inflammatory or derogatory scenes, pictures or displays. No entry that is considered political or controversial will be accepted. We reserve the right to eliminate your entry the day of the parade.
- 10. All entries are to take with them any trash and decorations when they leave the staging area and the parade route.

Regulations for Floats, Self-propelled and Vehicle Entries

- 1. All drivers must be in possession of appropriate valid driver's license and insurance.
- 2. Participants must remain on floats during the parade and an adult must properly supervise children.
- 3. No entry may be higher than 13 foot in order to clear power lines along the parade route.
- 4. All vehicles must be operated in a safe manner and at appropriate speeds. This includes vehicles within the staging area.
- 5. All entries must maintain a minimum of 30 foot distance from the entry in front of it.
- 6. Entries are to ensure the driver has a safe and clear view to operate and maneuver the entry along the parade route. Should an issue arise, public safety agencies will make the final determination.
- 7. Music is strongly encouraged. Please play music appropriate for the holiday.
- 8. Once your entry reaches the end of the parade route you will be directed to locations along 3rd and 4th Streets, where you can disembark passengers and decorations. Or you may choose to take Ferry Street directly back to the Staging Area for this task. **There is NO disembarking along Ferry Street.**
- 9. Vehicle Entries are only permitted two vehicles per entry. Vehicles range from golf cart or miniature riding apparatus to fire truck size.

Regulations for Animal Entry

- 1. Animal entries must incorporate the parade theme.
- 2. Animal entries shall exercise appropriate measures to keep spectators safe.
- 3. Animals must be bagged or followed by "scoopers" during the parade.
- 4. All Animal Entries must move from pre-staging to the main staging area 30 minutes prior to the parade start time. All entries MUST collect and remove all unused hay and feed as well as all manure prior to leaving.

Regulations for Walking Entry

- 1. Walking groups should wear costumes that reflect the parade theme. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended.
- 2. Due to the length of the parade route, we suggest entries plan for issues with small children not being able to complete the parade on foot.
