The SAC held its initial meeting on September 11, 2018. Our regular meetings are scheduled for November 13, January 8, March 12, and May 7. There may be additional special meetings. If you ever have an issue that you feel needs to be discussed by the SAC, please contact one of our members by Monday of the week prior to our meeting, and we will put that item on the agenda for discussion if appropriate.

Our SAC previously participated in developing a five-year plan that ends this school year. The plan covered multiple objectives, including academic goals, strengthening of our Catholic identity, expanding support programs for students and parents, and others. Most of the goals in the five year plan were reached, such as improving campus security by installing security gate, additional lighting, and cameras, and improving technology. Work will begin soon on developing a new plan to help guide our school through the next few years.

The majority of our regular work is done through four committees:

1. Finance Committee: David Walker serves as chair. This committee is responsible for working on the school budget, determining tuition/fee amounts, etc.
2. Facilities Committee: Brant Hanna serves as chair. This committee continues surveying our facilities and determining where we need repairs or upgrades. The outside bleacher project is a priority.
3. Enrollment and Retention Committee: Megan Sparks serves as chair. This committee looks at our enrollment numbers, and what we can do to improve those numbers and retain the students/families we have. The committee conducts surveys of parents, teachers, and 8th grade students to determine what the school does well and where it can improve.
4. Technology Committee: Tracey Childs serves as chair. This committee continues to survey what technology we have now, how it is used, what technology we need to improve or acquire, and what our technology curriculum should be going forward.

You do not have to be a member of the SAC to serve on one of these committees. We welcome more parent involvement. If you would like to help, or you have information you think would be useful, please contact the chair of that committee.
