The program will consist of recreation/activities, and homework help for students in the program is highly encouraged. MONDAY-FRIDAY GENERAL SCHEDULE

The general schedule for after school is as follows:

Snack
Outside Recess
Homework or Blackhawk Book Club
Recreation/Activities- Group and open games and activities

FRIDAY GENERAL SCHEDULE

Because Friday is a longer day it is as follows:

Snack (possibly twice), the 2nd snack might be popsicles, ice cream, fruit snacks etc.
Outside Recess (possibly twice)
Recreation/Activities - Group and open games and activities
Walking Field trips
Movies- G, PG family movies or cartoons
Computer lab-open time of computer, all computer browsing has filters and will be supervised

- Snack is provided everyday by our district student nutrition department.
- Homework is **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** Monday -Thursday for 30 minutes of after school. Homework is also a way for you to know what your child is working on in school. Please be sure to check in with your child to make sure homework is complete. Also encourage them to take advantage of this time to complete homework.
- Students will be able to access their phones during open recreation time as long as they are not consumed on the device and still participating in open Rec.
- During CGES athletic season gym time is limited and aftercare will spend more time in other available areas on campus
