Students will celebrate their First Communion at the 7:00 p.m. Maundy Thursday worship service on March 29. We encourage families to invite baptismal sponsors to attend the service. If you are unable to attend the Maundy Thursday service, the alternate date to celebrate First Communion is Easter Sunday, April 1, 2018.
