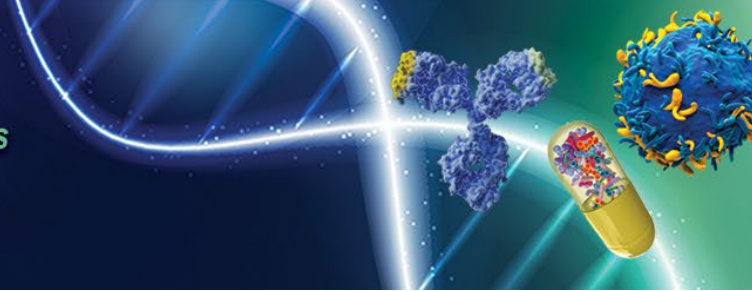

Robert Bies, PharmD, PhD

Dr. Bies is currently Professor of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Associate Dean for Graduate Education at the School of Pharmacy & Pharmaceutical Sciences as well as a member of the Inst for Artificial Intelligence & Data Science at the State Univ of New York at Buffalo. Prior to this, Dr. Bies was Associate Professor of Medicine and Medical & Molecular Genetics at the Indiana Univ School of Medicine and Director of the Disease & Therapeutic Response Modeling program for the Indiana Clinical Translational Sciences Inst. He serves on the editorial boards of the *Journal of Pharmacokinetics and Pharmacodynamics*, *Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics: Pharmacometrics and Systems Pharmacology*, *Biopharmaceutics and Drug Disposition*; *Clinical and Translational Science*; and the *British Journal of Clinical Pharmacology*. Dr. Bies is a member of the Int'l Society of Pharmacometrics (ISoP), American College of Clinical Pharmacology and American Society of Clinical Pharmacology & Therapeutics. He is also a Fellow of ISoP.

Dr. Bies received a BSc degree in Pharmacy from the Univ of Toronto (1991), a PharmD from the Univ of Texas Health Science Ctr San Antonio and the Univ of Texas at Austin (1994) and a PhD Pharmacology from Georgetown Univ in 1998. This was followed by postdoctoral training at the Center for Drug Development Sciences until 2000.

Dr. Bies has mentored over 26 graduate students at the Univ of Pittsburgh, Indiana Univ School of Medicine, The Univ at Buffalo and the Univ of North Carolina. These students have gone on to careers in regulatory agencies, academia and industry. This is in addition to mentoring many MD, PharmD and postdoctoral fellows.
