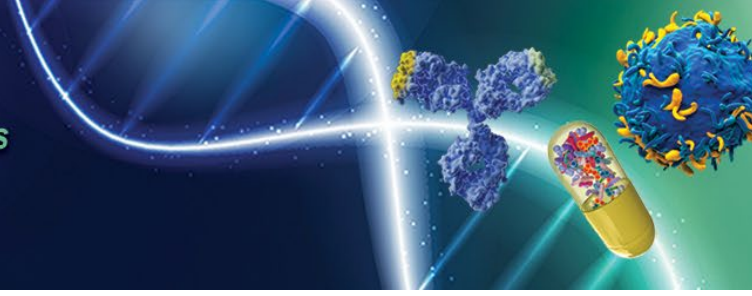

Professor Carl Kirkpatrick is a leading clinical pharmacologist whose work has advanced model-informed drug development, quantitative clinical pharmacology, and the quality use of medicines. As Professor of Pharmacy Practice at Monash Univ and inaugural Director of the Monash-Moderna Quantitative Pharmacology Accelerator, he has built an influential research portfolio spanning anti-infective dosing, translational pharmacology, and therapeutic innovation. His outstanding publication record (H-index 58, >13,100 citations, i10 index 158) reflects sustained impact in quantitative clinical pharmacology, medication optimization, and pharmacogenetics. He is widely recognised for his ability to bridge industry, academia, and regulatory practice, including collaborations with key Industry partners and valuable service to the Therapeutic Goods Administration. He has shaped the quantitative clinical pharmacology community through long-standing leadership within the Population Approach Group of Australia and New Zealand (PAGANZ) and engagement in major international scientific forums, including the World Conference on Pharmacometrics (WCoP). A nationally recognised educator and mentor, he has supervised more than 22 PhD candidates and strengthened pharmacy curricula by integrating quantitative clinical pharmacology and medication-safety principles, complemented by his Australian Award for University Teaching (2024). His leadership across Australasian Society of Clinical & Experimental Pharmacologists & Toxicologists (ASCEPT) and the Therapeutic Goods Administration, and his role as Chair of the World Congress of Pharmacology (WCP2026), together with his Fellowships in the British Pharmacological Society and ASCEPT, underscore his enduring impact on clinical pharmacology.
