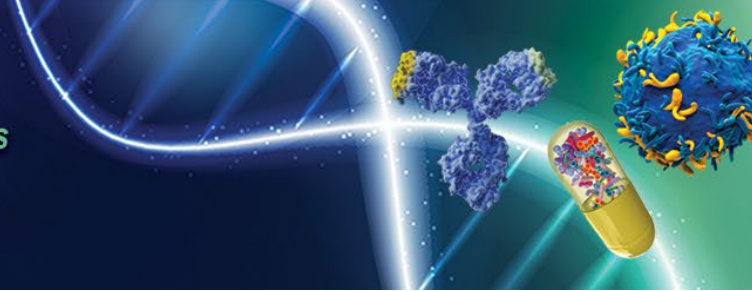

2026 McKeen Cattell Memorial Award

Peizhi Li, PharmD

PhD Candidate

Univ of Iowa College of Pharmacy

Dr. Peizhi Li is currently a PhD candidate in Pharmaceutics at the Univ of Iowa Coll of Pharmacy under the mentorship of Dr. Guohua An. She received her Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) degree from the Univ of Iowa College of Pharmacy in 2022. During her PhD training, Dr. Li's research centered on pharmacometrics and clinical pharmacology across different therapeutic areas, with an emphasis on model-informed approaches to address questions in public health policy, clinical care, and drug development.

One focus of Dr. Li's research is on characterizing the pharmacokinetics of THC and its major metabolites in humans after oral cannabis intake, along with the implications of THC blood concentration thresholds used in cannabis-impaired driving laws. This work was recognized by the 2026 McKeen Cattell Memorial Award. Additionally, Dr. Li has worked on antibiotic dose optimization in special populations such as pregnant women undergoing cesarean delivery, as well as modeling approaches to support antibody-drug conjugate development. Her work has been published in several peer-reviewed journals and presented at clinical pharmacology and pharmacometrics conferences.
