CALL FOR LEGISLATIVE IDEAS MARCH 2019

RAM members are invited to submit their legislative ideas to RAM's Legislative Committee for consideration at its **APRIL 11** Committee Meeting. *RAM Staff are happy to review and consult with you on your proposal but cannot write it for you.*

PROPOSALS DUE MARCH 29, 2019

Legislative Proposals must be received by **FRIDAY, MARCH 29, 2019**. Proposal authors must attend the April 11th Legislative Committee Meeting to present their idea. If unavailable, they must find a representative to present the proposal on their behalf or it will not be considered.



RAM LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING APRIL 11, 2019

Following the parliamentary process, RAM's Legislative Committee will discuss each proposal and either approve or defeat each one. It will then rank in priority order the proposals it will submit to the Medical Society of Virginia for consideration at their APRIL 26, 2019 Advocacy Summit. (NOTE: Any MSV member may submit a proposal directly to MSV for consideration as an individual submission)



NEXT STEPS

Final Legislative Committee recommendations from the **APRIL 11** Committee Meeting will be recorded and sent to the RAM Board Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will make the final recommendations on which proposals are submitted to the Medical Society of Virginia for consideration at their **APRIL 26** Advocacy Summit.
