- * All work must be designed and/or hand-crafted and sold by the Artist.
- * A review committee will jury art/craft work.
- * Artists may sell only those items approved by the committee.
- * There will be no agent or third party selling. You must be a current member of the SCAC. * We reserve the right to deny participation to anyone not meeting SCAC standards. Persons selling items not approved by the review committee will be asked to remove the items and will not be invited back.

REGISTRATION:

- * Each application will be judged individually. We must have three color photos of the work you will be selling. It is essential that your photos accurately and clearly show your work. No Polaroid's. If an artist is not selected for participation, pictures of the art will be returned.
- * Applications are due by September 24, 2021.
