Required Qualifications:

- **MSW graduate in Clinical Social Work from an accredited School of Social Work
- **IS Number issued from the 491 Board of the State of Florida
- **All required coursework completed, preferably with electives in trauma symptomatology, DSM
Diagnosis and treatment interventions/best practices
- **Coursework in CBT (Cognitive Behavior Therapy)
- **Strong interest and passion for serving traumatized children and adolescents in school-based settings
- **Willingness to work in school-based setting for 3 years (two as a clinical intern and one upon
completion of clinical supervision)
- **Willingness to complete subsidized Trauma-focused CBT training and become certificate-ready
(licensure is required for obtaining full certification)
- **Willingness to complete C-SSRS Training and become effective at identifying suicidal lethality in
children and adolescents.
