BIOSTATISTICS

Students who choose the MPH with a concentration in biostatistics learn to understand and interpret data driven by research – a skillset that is at the forefront of the public health field.

Biostatistics students at Stempel College have the opportunity to collaborate across public health disciplines to extract and analyze data across the college's areas of research.

ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SCIENCES (EHS)

The graduate level Environmental Health Sciences (EHS) programs prepare students for professional roles where they will apply mechanism-based and evidence-based research to help detect, prevent and control adverse influences of the environment on human health.

The EHS department advocates for research-led teaching, so students receive first-hand experience working with an interdisciplinary faculty that includes toxicologists, neuroscientists, cancer scientists, pharmacists, molecular biologists and environmental/water resource scientists.

EPIDEMIOLOGY

Choosing epidemiology positions students to find solutions to serious public health problems like cardiovascular disease and cancer.

Epidemiology students have the opportunity to work alongside researchers who are investigating Latino health, LGBTQ health, health disparities, tobacco control, women's health, and HIV/AIDS.

HEALTH POLICY AND MANAGEMENT (HPM)

Students in Health Policy and Management (HPM) are poised for careers in health care management, health economics and population health management.

The department's faculty and staff inspire students as they engage in research focused on public health policy analysis, health economics, and health systems analysis.

HEALTH PROMOTION AND DISEASE PREVENTION (HPDP)

Health Promotion and Disease Prevention gives students the tools they need to address the behavioral, social and cultural factors related to individual, community, population health and health disparities over the life course.

Students can expect to work on research that includes HIV/AIDS, health disparities, diabetes and obesity interventions, asthma, and community-based participatory research.
