PGCEA TREASURER

On August 1, 2021, the position of PGCEA Treasurer will become vacant. The person currently holding this position, Dr. Donna Christy, will begin her new role as PGCEA President. In accordance with the [PGCEA ByLaws](#): Article IV:

Officers; Section 3: Election and Term of office (D) states, “If the office of Treasurer should become vacant, the NECC will conduct a special election at the next Representative Council to fill the unexpired term. Only current members of the Board of Directors shall be eligible to run. Following an election to fill a vacancy, if the individual elected is not eligible to assume the position at the prescribed time, the position will be offered to the person receiving the next highest number of votes. “

This means, the NECC will conduct an election during the August Representative Council Meeting (first meeting of the fiscal year) to fill the position of Treasurer that will become vacant on August 1, 2021. **Only members of the Board of Directors, at that time,** will be eligible candidates to fill the position to *complete the term* of the current Treasurer.

During the first meeting of the PGCEA Representative Council, following the election of the PGCEA Treasurer in August 2021, the NECC will announce the vacancy of one (1) Board of Directors Seats: one left vacant when a Treasurer is elected.

In accordance with the [PGCEA ByLaws](#): Article VI - Board of Directors; Section 5: Vacancies states, “Vacancies on the Board of Directors except the offices of President, Vice President, and Treasurer shall be filled through an election at the Representative Council within 60 days of the announcement of the vacancies. The Nominations, Elections, and Credentials Commission (NECC) will declare the vacancy. Nominations may be taken in advance or the first fifteen (15) minutes of the council where the election will be held.”

This means that any documented member of the PGCEA Representative Council may be elected to complete the terms left vacant – in this instance that is the seat currently held by a current member of the Board of Director elected to complete the term of Treasurer.

MSEA & NEA DELEGATES



The NECC will meet soon to certify the results for MSEA and NEA Delegates.

Today, the PGCEA Communications Department will upload the 2021 General Election Results for President, Vice-President and Board of Directors.

Once the NECC has certified the MSEA and NEA Delegate results, all 2021 PGCEA General Election results will be posted to the PGCEA website as soon as this task is complete.

This is a 1-year term.
