

Dr. Kristie Brooks, Superintendent of Chattahoochee County Schools, has served in her position as Superintendent since 2019. During her tenure, Chattahoochee County Schools has annually earned Exemplary Status from the Georgia School Board Association. The District has also been recognized for the Leading-Edge Award for best practices in Culture and Climate, Communications, and Continuous Improvement. Chattahoochee County Schools is the only public-school system to have all three school levels named as a Military Flagship School. Most recently, GaDOE named Chattahoochee County Elementary as a Literacy Leader school. As a 2023 GSBA finalist for Governance Team of the Year, Dr. Brooks and her team continue to model the OneHeartBeat motto of Chattahoochee County Schools.

Dr. Brooks began her career in public education in 1998 as a reading specialist and special education teacher. Previously, she has served as a building level administrator and central office leader in Hall, Oconee, and Jasper County schools. As a recipient of Georgia's Pace Setter Award for Outstanding Special Education Services, Dr. Brooks has successfully led programs for English as a Second Language, gifted, and students with disabilities across suburban and rural Georgia.

Dr. Brooks received her undergraduate degree from the State University of West Georgia and a Master's of Education from the University of North Georgia. She received her Educational Administration certification from the University of Georgia and was then awarded the prestigious Presidential Scholarship at Regent University in Virginia to pursue her Educational Doctorate with a focus on conducting a meta-analysis of reading research for Georgia students enrolled in Reading First schools.

Dr. Brooks serves on various regional and state boards across Georgia and the southeast with a focus on the unique needs of rural education. She and her husband, Dwayne, have two children. Wesley, a soon to be graduate of Georgia Tech, will be pursuing a career in Computer Science with a specialization in Modeling and Simulation and Intelligence. Kate will graduate from Chattahoochee County High School completing her TCGS certificate in Healthcare Science as she pursues post-secondary training in the nursing field.
