


# Stages for Reentry to School - Fall 2020

## STAGE 1: COMPREHENSIVE DISTANCE LEARNING

All students participate in distance learning. School buildings are closed for public access. Teachers and staff have access to school buildings following physical distancing guidelines and coordinated by the on-site physical distance coordinator.

### Decision Criteria:

- Stay Home, Save Lives order issued by the Governor in coordination with Oregon Health Authority



## STAGE 2: COMPREHENSIVE DISTANCE LEARNING PLUS

All students participate in distance learning. Limited in-school supports may be offered by the District\*. Teachers and staff have access to school buildings following physical distancing guidelines and coordinated by the on-site physical distance coordinator.

*\*E.g. testing and evaluation, in-person tutoring for students with unique needs, etc.*

### Decision Criteria:

- Washington County Case Rate: more than 30 cases per 100,000 in the preceding seven days
- Washington County Test Positivity Rate: greater than 10% in the preceding seven days
- State of Oregon Test Positivity Rate: greater than 5% in the preceding seven days

## STAGE 3: HYBRID LEARNING FOR GRADES PreK-3

Students in grades PreK-3 may attend school daily while continuing to do Comprehensive Distance Learning. Students in grades 4-12 engage in Comprehensive Distance Learning. Limited small group, in-school supports may be offered. Staff can be on-site for planning and delivering instruction.

### Decision Criteria:

- Washington County Case Rate: Fewer than 30 cases per 100,000 in the preceding seven days for three weeks in a row
- Washington County Test Positivity Rate: 5% or less in the preceding seven days for three weeks in a row
- COVID-19 is not actively spreading in the school community
- District complying with sections 1-3 of Ready Schools, Safe Learners Guidance

## STAGE 4: HYBRID LEARNING FOR GRADES PreK-12

Students in grades PreK-3\* may attend school daily. Students in grades 4-12 may attend school for at least two days a week (M-Th or T-F). Some students may receive additional supports on Wednesdays. Staff can be on-site for planning and delivering instruction.

*\*If all students are participating in hybrid learning, every day options may be available to fewer grade levels.*

### Decision Criteria:

- Washington County Case Rate: 10 or fewer cases per 100,000 in the preceding seven days for three weeks in a row
- Washington County Test Positivity Rate: 5% or less in the preceding seven days for three weeks in a row
- State of Oregon Test Positivity Rate: 5% or less in the preceding seven days for three weeks in a row

## STAGE 5: IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION FOR GRADES PreK-12

Students in grades PreK-12 attend school daily.

### Decision Criteria:

- COVID-19 is sufficiently under control in the community as determined by state and local health authorities
- Current Executive Orders are lifted

**If schools are in any phase of in-person learning, they will return to Comprehensive Distance Learning if the following are true:**

- Washington County Case Rate: 20 or more cases per 100,000 in the preceding seven days
- Washington County Text Positivity Rate: 7.5% or more in the preceding seven days
- Positive cases of COVID-19 identified at a school and/or active spread in the school community
