

New York State Census Equity Fund Grantees as of July 2019

- **Asian American Federation** - \$100,000 to ensure that all Asian New Yorkers are counted in the 2020 Census.
- **Craig Newmark Graduate School of Journalism/CUNY (Center for Community and Ethnic Media)** - \$70,000 to help community and ethnic news organizations in the City and neighboring counties promote Get-Out-The-Count efforts in preparation for the 2020 Census.
- **Health and Welfare Council of Long Island** - \$75,000 to provide training, tools and resources to the Nassau and Suffolk County Complete Count Committees to reach hard-to-count communities and populations across Long Island.
- **The New School (Digital Equity Lab)** - \$100,000 to help public libraries in New York State provide internet access and support to marginal populations to improve census participation.
- **Partnership for the Public Good** - \$58,000 to provide census training and tools to community organizations in Western New York to engage hard-to-count populations and communities in the 2020 Census.
- **New York Immigration Coalition** - \$100,000 to provide technical assistance to community organizations in Western and Central New York to help them engage hard-to-count populations in the 2020 Census.
- **New York Civic Engagement Table** - \$55,000 to provide training and technical assistance to organizations involved in census outreach in the Hudson Valley.
- **Nelson A. Rockefeller Institute of Government** - \$35,000 to do an analysis of hard-to-count areas and constituencies throughout the state.
- **New York Engage** - \$30,000 for communications and staffing support for NYSCEF Steering Committee and subcommittees.
