Makiyah began her journey as a Child Development Floater Apprentice on October 14, 2024, through a registered apprenticeship program sponsored by Choanoke Area Development Association, INC (CADA). With a requirement of 1,000 hours of on-the-job training and related classroom instruction, Makiyah has completed all program requirements and will graduate today, May 9, 2025.

This achievement is a testament to the power of registered apprenticeships—an industry-driven, high-quality career pathway that allows individuals to gain paid work experience, receive mentoring, earn progressive wages, complete relevant coursework, and earn a portable, nationally recognized credential.
