



In the second letter to Timothy, the Apostle Paul recalls the upbringing of his younger disciple, whom he considered to be like a spiritual son. Paul says, “I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that lived first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, lives in you.” (2 Timothy 1:5 NRSV). The Apostle remembers how Timothy’s faith was inherited from and nurtured by his elders in such a way that it became his own “sincere” faith.

In addition to that, Great Bridge United Methodist Church approached us with an interest in working with the garden to augment their own food pantry which serves currently about 50 families every Friday afternoon. After some discussion, they have agreed to become partners with Centerville Baptist. They will be bringing some funding, enthusiastic workers, and new ideas to keep this ministry alive and improve our impact in the community. All of us on the garden team are so excited about the possibilities this new partnership brings. The one decision made was to rename our garden to 'The Fentress Giving Garden' to more specifically relay our location and purpose. We will bring more details later.






