

The Fentress Giving Garden

A collaborative, interdenominational food ministry

The 2022 Fentress Giving Garden experienced a lot of really good changes this year. Our motto “ We Plant . . . God Grows” was realized abundantly by:

- becoming a significant supplier of fresh vegetables to local church sponsored good pantries
- Changing our name: A name. Yes, Fentress is where we are and “giving” is what we do
- Harvesting over 11,300 lbs of produce so far this year
- Gleaning 275 dozen ears of sweet corn from a local farmer
- Starting a garden ministry with SECEP children from Chesapeake public schools
- Merging our program with GBUMC
- Adding new workers from several area churches
- Creating a partnership with a local farmer to help us take care of the field around the garden
- Cultivating several new relationships with area farmers
- Receiving over 100 visitors to the garden this year
- Producing and gleaning a variety of seasonal vegetables that when prepared would make about 26,200 servings

With time help and prayers we will continue to harvest fall crops and hope to do some facility improvements this fall and winter to prepare for the next spring growing season.

Women In Action

We hope you were able to take part in our Hanging of the Green service on November 27th. It was such a joy to see so many of you hanging the Chrismon's on the tree. We want to remind you about that the Chrismon's are in white and gold to represent Christ's purity and God's majesty. The ornaments are fashioned in symbols to honor Jesus and His teachings. The evergreen tree symbolizes the eternal life Christ offers His followers and the tree's white lights proclaim Christ's role as light of the world. Most of the Chrismons on our tree were made by the WOMEN ON MISSIONS here in our church dating back to the 1980's.

Please enjoy and remember our loving Christ who saves us.



On December 4th we will begin our offering for Foreign Missions. This year the offering will combine the Lottie Moon Offering and the Global Missions Offering. Both of these offerings help to support missionaries who are sharing Christ around the world. If you prefer one offering over the other simply write that on your envelope. 
