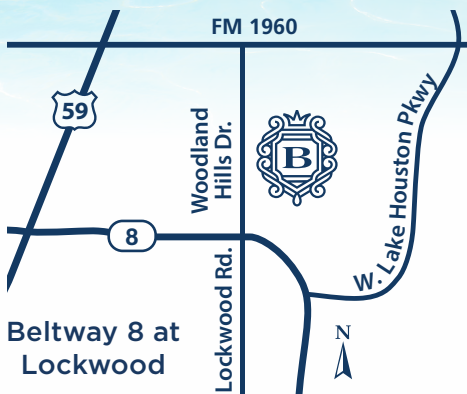

* The cost of a "Friends and Family" privilege as of the effective date of this notification is \$300 per for a family. The "Friends and Family" privilege will expire on September 7th, 2020.
