

ROSEMARY HARTOUNIAN COHEN is a sociologist who earned her doctorate degree at the Sorbonne in Paris. She is an accomplished artist, award-winning author fluent in many languages and lived in several countries, studying their traditions, literature and religions. Her grandmother Arousiak and mother, Liana, were the sole survivors of the Armenian Massacre in the city of Khoy, Persia (now Iran), in 1918. Rosemary described their suffering and near-miraculous escape in *The Survivor*, published in five languages. She has lived with the “silentvoiced” survivors of the massacre and has learned of their enormous inner pain. Her books are aimed towards peace and understanding and not for revenge seeking. Still, she hopes one day to hear a word of regret from the deniers who have caused so much pain to so many innocent people!
