



NJAC WINTER SPORTS SPECTATOR POLICY

FEBRUARY 12, 2021

The Northwest Jersey Athletic Conference has updated the conference spectator policy for winter sports. The NJAC Board of Governors approved the following at a meeting on Friday, February 12, 2021. The ability of the home school to accommodate any spectators depends on each facility and therefore this general policy can be more restrictive as need determines.

Basketball, Fencing, Volleyball and Wrestling -

- a. Each member school shall prepare to accept spectators by Monday, February 15, if the facility can accommodate spectators.
- b. Each member school shall follow all health and safety Covid-19 guidelines as per NJSIAA and their individual school/district policies.
- c. Member schools may permit a maximum of two (2) parents/guardians per **HOME** varsity level athlete to be in attendance during a varsity contest.
- d. If a member school can accommodate, the school may permit a maximum of two (2) parents/guardians per **HOME** sub-level athlete to be in attendance during a contest.
- e. Parents/guardians who are permitted to attend contests must leave the facility immediately upon completion of the contest.

Bowling -

- a. The two bowling facilities, Rockaway and Sparta Lanes, are restricted to 35% capacity.
- b. Due to capacity limitations, member schools may permit a maximum of two (2) **SENIOR** parents/guardians only. This may be reduced to one (1) **SENIOR** parent/guardian, if necessary due to facility restrictions.

Swimming - Due to facility restrictions **NO** spectators are permitted in any NJAC swim facility.
