

February 2020 QPP Fast Facts

Call for measures is open until February 7th

CMS is accepting recommendations from stakeholders for potential consideration of new specialty measure sets and/or revisions to existing specialty measure sets for the 2021 program year. In addition, recommendations will be accepted based on potential new MIPS measures that are being considered for implementation in the 2021 program year.

- Submissions of recommendations for a new specialty measure set and/or revisions to the current 2020 specialty measure sets should be sent to the PIMMS Quality Measures Support mailbox:
 - PIMMSQualityMeasuresSupport@git.com
 - CMS specifically requests stakeholder feedback on applicable quality measures for the following specialties: Addiction Medicine, Critical Care (Intensivists), Hospice and Palliative Care Medicine, Medical Genetics and Genomics, Pain Management/Interventional Pain Management and Sleep Medicine.
- Each recommendation **must** include the following in order to be considered:
 - The quality measure ID
 - Measure title
 - Supporting rationale and/or documentation that would support inclusion or exclusion of the current quality measure(s) from existing specialty measure sets or inclusion in new specialty measure sets.
- **Submissions accepted until Close of Business on Friday, February 7th, 2020**

Due to the opening of the 2019 MIPS data submission period, the Quality Payment Program (QPP) Service Center is projecting an increase in volume of calls and emails between January and March 2020, resulting in longer wait times.

CMS recommends the following to minimize wait times and ensure successful 2019 submission:

- **Use One Method to Report Issues**— Due to the increase in volume at the QPP Service Center and to minimize backlog, please use only one method of reporting for the same issue (email or phone). Note: Cases are processed in the order which they are received

regardless of the manner in which the Service Center was contacted. Please allow time for processing.

- **Submit Your Data Early**— We encourage you to submit your 2019 MIPS performance period data early during the submission period. Early submission will allow you plenty of time for Service Center assistance if needed.
- **Call the Service Center at Off-Peak Hours**— We strongly recommend calling the Service Center during off-peak hours (8:00 AM-10:00 AM ET *OR* 2:00 PM-8:00 PM ET).

Check Your Initial 2020 MIPS Eligibility on the QPP Website

You can now use the updated CMS [Quality Payment Program Participation Status Lookup Tool](#) to check on your initial 2020 eligibility for the Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS). Just enter your National Provider Identifier, or NPI, to find out whether you need to participate in MIPS during the 2020 performance period.

Low Volume Threshold Requirements

To be eligible to participate in MIPS in 2020, you must:

- Bill **more than \$90,000** a year in allowed charges for covered professional services under the Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (PFS), **AND**
- Furnish covered professional services to **more than 200** Medicare Part B beneficiaries, **AND**
- Provide **more than 200** covered professional services under the PFS.

If you **do not exceed all three of the above criteria** for the 2020 performance period, you are excluded from MIPS. However, you have the opportunity to opt-in to MIPS and receive a payment adjustment if you meet or exceed one or two, but not all, of the low-volume threshold criteria. Alternatively, you may choose to voluntarily report to MIPS and not receive a payment adjustment if you do not meet any of the low-volume threshold criteria or if you meet some, but not all, of the criteria.

Note: The 2020 Eligibility Tool Update for QPs/APMs will be updated at a later time.

Additionally, the tool will be updated in late 2020 to indicate final MIPS eligibility.
