

Crime and Punishment for This Week

Ms. Chloe Perriman, manager of the Rite Aid Drug Store at 1100 Hammond Drive, saved a woman a lot of heartache and about \$500 when she recognized a scam. A 54-year old woman was in the process of purchasing two pre-paid gift cards after receiving a call from someone who said they were with the DeKalb County Sheriff's Department and who informed the woman she missed jury duty resulting in a fine that could be paid by a gift card. (*Okay, that alone is ridiculous.*) The officer called the number listed but it had been disconnected.

She has since received more "checks," coming from Memphis, TN, that were later put into PD evidence. I'm not sure how much she lost on this deal.
