Becoming a certified psychodramatist may be one of the most fulfilling and exciting undertakings of your professional life. Because of the intense commitment of time, energy and financial resources, pursuing certification is not a decision to take lightly. For anyone considering certification and for those already committed, it is important to ***understand what is required*** and to ***develop practical methods and tools to track and document your progress***.

What To Expect:

- Leave with a better understanding of the required hours of psychodrama training and supervised clinical experience needed for certification. This is especially important now because the Board recently established new rules for distance learning hours.
- Receive information about the written and onsite examinations.
- Explore ways to document and track your progress.

Let this training help you make wise and informed choices about whether or not to pursue the Certified Practitioner credential. If you are already committed to the journey, leave the session with greater clarity about how to meet and track the certification requirements.
