Students living in or attending school in the Lamorinda area (including all schools in the Acalanes School District) are welcome to register for the competition. The competition showcases student art in four categories: 2D, 3D, photography, and the Lamorinda Arts Alliance sponsored digital art category. Professional judges with experience in practicing or teaching the above categories judge the competition. The criteria used for judging include: creativity and originality; content and degree of expertise in the chosen medium. The competition features cash awards totaling \$3000 and merit citations, as well as inclusion in the online gallery on the LAC website. Winners will be announced on the Live Artists & Awards Show on March 11th at 7pm. Entries accepted for the HSVAC will be on display online for public viewing from March 1, 2021 until updated in 2022.
